Hello,

This is to remind you of the upcoming Moodle upgrade scheduled to take place on **Monday, April 29th**, and **Tuesday, April 30th, 2024**. This upgrade from version 3.9 to 4.1 will bring new features and a refreshed user interface to Moodle.

Here are some of the new features coming to Moodle!

- In Moodle 4.1, all navigation tabs, such as Home, My Courses, and others, will be consolidated and moved to the top of the page to enhance ease of navigation.
- The Dashboard will now include a Timeline feature to filter events by dates and a Calendar view in addition to the existing features.
- Moodle 4.1 will introduce more prominent icons for activities and resources, making them easier to identify.
- Participants and grades tabs will be placed at the top of the course main page, eliminating the need to collapse course sections or scroll down to access these tabs.
