Family and friends are requested to rise when the graduands' procession enters. The assembly is requested to remain standing until the conclusion of the singing of *O Canada*.

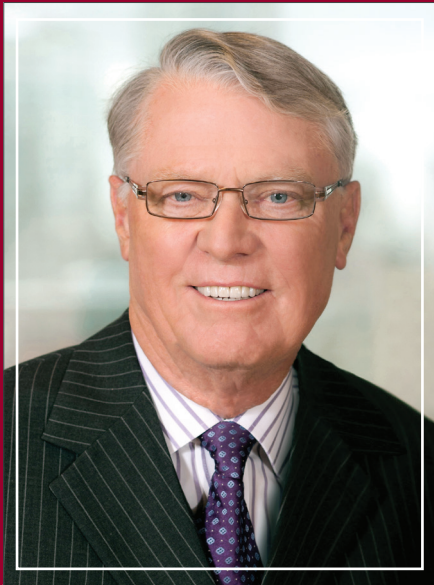
Convocation will conclude with the recession of the platform party, floor party and graduates, during which everyone is requested to remain standing.

## *Honorary Doctor of Laws (Honoris Causa)*



### **Ann and Michael Wilson**

Michael and Ann Wilson are considered to be true humanitarians. They have dedicated their lives to be advocates of social justice and to help those in our community who are unable to help themselves. Their goal is to help those dealing with homelessness, addiction and unemployment by providing resources and services to lift them up so they might achieve personal success.

Michael is the founding Executive Director of the Phoenix Society in Surrey, BC and Ann is the organization's Director of Program Development. Through mobilizing partnerships with all levels of government, educational institutions, community organizations and various donors, they have developed an innovative centre that incorporates an integrated addiction services model with a collaborative social and economic approach addressing interconnected issues. The participant success rate in treatment outcomes is 80% and employment outcomes is 70 – 80%. These impressive results of the Phoenix Centre was identified as a “best practice” by the BC Premier’s Task Force on Homelessness, Mental Illness and Addictions under the Provincial Homelessness Initiative.

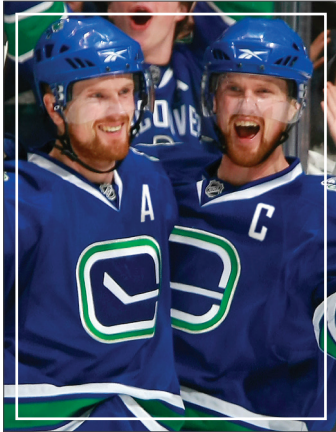
In 2013 Michael received a PhD in Human and Organizational Development from Fielding Graduate University, Santa Barbara, California. He was awarded the Citizen of the Year Award from the City of Surrey in 2015. Ann completed a doctoral degree in Transformational Change in the Faculty of Education at Simon Fraser University.

Ann serves as the Director of Program Development at the Phoenix Drug and Alcohol Recovery and Education Society, a position which entails broad responsibility as operations manager overseeing not only Program Design and Quality Assurance, but also fundraising, community and public relations, project and human resource management. Ann was instrumental in developing a unique adult literacy program designed to reach marginalized and multi-barriered learners affected by addiction, homelessness, poverty and social exclusion.

Together, Ann and Michael Wilson have not only made their organization notably successful organization, they have helped many individuals to overcome multiple barriers and go on to lead healthy, successful and productive lives.

### **Daniel and Henrik Sedin**

Originally from Örnsköldsvik, Sweden, Henrik and Daniel Sedin were drafted by the Vancouver Canucks in the 1999 NHL Entry Draft. Today, Henrik leads the Canucks all-time in a number of statistical categories including games played, assists and points. Daniel leads the club in franchise goals, powerplay goals, overtime goals, and game-winning goals.

While their skills and leadership on the ice have gained the Sedins notoriety, what isn't well known is how they are humble humanitarians.

Over the years their support has benefitted more than 50 charities, most notably the Canucks For Kids Fund, the Canucks Family Education Centre, Canuck Place Children's Hospice, the YWCA and BC Children's Hospital.

Daniel and Henrik Sedin, along with their wives, also created their own charity, the Sedin Family Foundation that celebrates people, recognizes achievement and addresses the needs of families and children. The foundation works with schools, community groups, and social service agencies to identify needs and find ways to make a difference for children and families.

One particular local initiative the Sedin Family Foundation has supported is Club 36. Launched in 2015, Club 36 is operated by Surrey Schools and the YMCA of Greater Vancouver providing programming for at-risk and vulnerable Surrey students. One of the objectives of Club 36 is to allow students to try a wide variety of new activities, develop new passions and interests and to consider new goals for their future. Students gain life skills, confidence, leadership abilities, and academic learning, enhancing the possibility for them to pursue post-secondary

## *Honorary Doctor of Laws (Honoris Causa)*



### **Dr. Jo-ann Archibald Q'um Q'um Xiem**

Dr. Jo-ann Archibald is of Stó:lō and Xaxli'p ancestry. Her career extends over 40 years and has been marked with a considerable amount of success as an educator, leader and author in the field of Indigenous Education. Jo-ann is a professor of educational studies at the University of British Columbia (UBC) where she also served as associate dean for Indigenous education and director of the Faculty of Education's Indigenous Teacher Education Program, NITEP.

Jo-ann's work has shaped Indigenous education through curriculum, program development, policy, teaching and research.

She is a visionary and change-agent, and has enhanced Indigenous education in many ways. She is the author of a book *Indigenous Storywork: Educating the Heart, Mind, Body, and Spirit*. Her book is held as a sacred vision by Coast Salish Elders and has been cited and referenced as a seminal work in the field of Indigenous knowledge systems and community protocol. At UBC, she served as the Director of the First Nations House of Learning and worked with the faculties of Arts, Agricultural Sciences, Law and many others to develop and implement Indigenous projects.

Jo-ann is also nationally recognized for creating culturally relevant teacher education and graduate programs for Aboriginal students. In her role as the Associate Dean for Indigenous Education in the Faculty of Education she advanced a number of initiatives including the SAGE (Supporting Aboriginal Graduate Enhancement) and Faculty of Education's "Year of Indigenous Education".

Jo-ann has received a great deal of recognition for her work. In 2000, she received a National Aboriginal Achievement/Inspire Award and the Simon Fraser University Outstanding Alumni Award for Academic Achievement in 2012. In 2013, she received a distinguished career achievement award from the American Education Research Association, Scholars of Colour. In 2015, Jo-ann was presented with the UBC Killam Award for Excellence in Mentoring.

## Professor Emerita



**Noemi Gal-Or, Ph.D., LL.B.,** *Retired Faculty of Arts Instructor, Political Science*

From 1991 until January 2017, Dr. Noemi Gal-Or was a KPU Faculty Member in the department of Political Science. From 2000 to 2002 she was the Chair for the Study Group on Trans-Border Politics, Business, Society and Law, and from 2002 to 2013 Dr. Gal-Or was the Director for the Institute for Transborder Studies.

Dr. Gal-Or has been an exemplary “builder” at KPU. She developed its first research institute (the Institute for Trans-Border Studies), spearheaded the development of its first full BA degree in Political Science, and was indispensable in nurturing Political Science from a fledgling program to an integral part of the Faculty of Arts. Every student who has taken a degree in Political Science has benefitted, either indirectly, or more often, directly, from her endeavours.

Dr. Gal-Or’s scholarship is one of the most dedicated and productive in the history of our university, building a truly impressive body of work on international law, terrorism, and global justice. She has published three well-reviewed books on terrorism, and co-edited three important collections on questions of international justice, security, and conflict resolution, along with a special issue of *Peace Review*. Her output as an author of book chapters, articles, and research reports is remarkable. Since 2008 she has published in many journals such as the *International Criminal Law Review*, *Journal of Parliamentary and Political Law*, *Journal of International Organization Studies*, *Journal of Human Security*, *The Journal of Conflict Studies*, *Canadian Political Science Review*, and *Religion & Human Rights*. She has also contributed several reports for the Non State Actor Committee of the International Law Association. Her prolific output extends back to 1988: a record of dedicated scholarship spanning almost 30 years.

The KPU community is grateful for all the contributions Dr. Gal-Or provided to both the institution and its students and is pleased that her relationship with the university shall continue.

Having been raised in rural prairie Canada, Leanne grew up learning about agriculture and developed an appreciation for social and environmental issues that surround it. 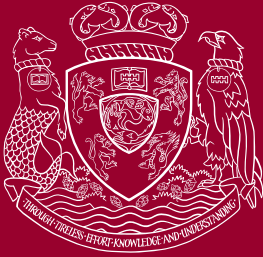
Joanne's career goals are to become a Registered Interior Designer and eventually become an interior design professor at the university level.

# *Convocation Traditions*



## Heraldry



The Arms of Kwantlen Polytechnic University were presented at a ceremony on May 4, 1999 by the Right Honourable Romeo LeBlanc, Governor General of Canada.

The centre shield features "The Spirit of KPU" emblem comprising a wolf, a salmon, and a river azure as styled by Brandon Gabriel.

At the top of the blue shield, on the left side a lion and on the right a tiger facing each other in the rampant position (upright on one hind leg with forelegs outstretched as if attacking). And at the bottom of the blue shield, on the left a jaguar and on the right a Chinese dragon also facing each other in the rampant position. All are gold.

At the top in the centre, there is an open book with silver or white pages, bindings in gold and on top of it, a gold horizontal (in fess) rectangle (billet) with square bites taken out of the long sides (bretessed). In modern heraldry, this item is meant to represent a computer chip.

The crest appears above the shield, and is supported by a silver and blue twisted fabric wreath. The upper rim is set with a simple silver crown, the upper edge decorated with four salmon, looking at each other in pairs.

Supporting the arms is a green grassy mound, scattered with gold Douglas Fir cones. The mound is rising from wavy horizontal bands of blue and silver. This is the traditional heraldic representation of water - either river or ocean.

On the left is a gold female deer with blue hooves, and her bottom half is a silver fishtail with gold fins. Around her neck is a wreath of twisted silver and blue cloth. Hanging from the wreath is a green disk with an open book on it—the pages are silver; the cover is gold.

On the right is a gold eagle with a silver head, with blue talons and beak. Around his neck is a wreath like the doe's and hanging from it is a green disk with the heraldic representation of a gold computer chip.

The motto reads: Through Tireless Effort, Knowledge and Understanding.

## University Mace



The mace was originally a weapon during the medieval period, and came to be associated with the prowess and strength of the knight. Today the mace is a symbol of the University's authority to award degrees and diplomas. It indicates the seriousness of convocation as the University's most important academic ceremony, and is a confirmation of the University's integrity as an academic institution. The mace is carried by a mace-bearer, who leads the processional of faculty and students in to and out of the venue where convocation is held.

The mace is usually between 120 cm and 180 cm in length and will incorporate the history and tradition that surround the vision for the University.

An academic mace symbolizes the authority vested in the chancellor to confer University credentials. This is why the mace is an integral part of convocation.

Maces are often commissioned to commemorate a milestone anniversary or presidential inauguration. Typically an artist is selected for the honour to develop a highly symbolic design that incorporates the University's traditions.

KPU's mace was carved by Kwantlen First Nation artist Drew Atkins.



## Regalia

Not until they slip into their regalia, do many graduands realize the significance of their convocation ceremony. For family and friends, the first glimpse of the graduand in cap and gown heralds a milestone in the life of their loved one.

### Standard for Academic Dress

At KPU, all graduates wear a black gown of Oxford shape and a black cap with a black tassel. Graduates of our bachelor's degree programs wear hoods in the Aberdeen style, made of black pilgrim cloth and bordered with a one half inch border. The border of each hood is a specific colour that identifies a particular area of study.

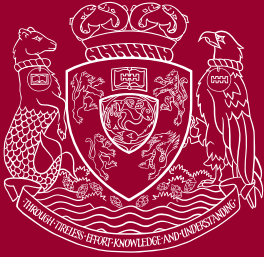

The gown is of Oxford shape using maroon pilgrim cloth for the body and sleeves, with three navy blue velvet chevrons and silver velvet panels. Hoods for honorary graduates are of intercollegiate style, maroon in colour to match the gowns, with a sugarbeet satin lining, a silver satin chevron and trim, and grey piping.
