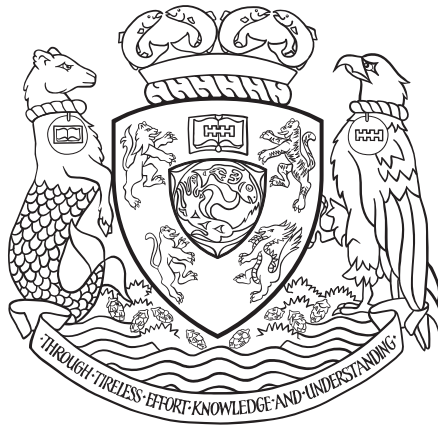

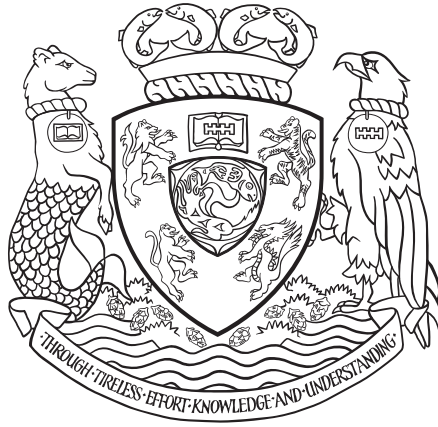

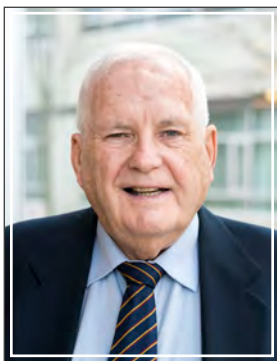

## Honorary Doctor of Laws (Honoris Causa)



### Ken Hahn

A graduate of Owen Sound Collegiate in Ontario, Ken Hahn joined the Bank of Commerce and for over a decade, worked in human resources in branches across Ontario. In 1975, Ken was transferred to Vancouver, and worked as the personnel manager for British Columbia and the Yukon.

With a desire to remain in B.C., he joined the credit union system, beginning as director of human resources, and then vice president for Surrey Credit Union, before moving into executive roles with the Richmond Savings Credit Union and Credit Union Central of British Columbia.

In 1996, Ken returned to Surrey Credit Union—which had by then become Surrey Metro Savings—as the senior vice president of human resources and remained in that role as SMS merged with Richmond Savings and Pacific Coast Savings to form Coast Capital Savings. He remained with Coast Capital until he retired in 2007.

A Fellow of the Institute of Canadian Banking and a Fellow of the Credit Union Institute, Ken has won numerous awards, including the Charter Professionals in Humans Resources of BC Award of Excellence and a nomination for excellence in Human Resources by the Society for Human Resource Management.

Outside of his professional career, Ken has been actively involved in the community, coaching baseball, serving as an executive with North Delta Minor Hockey, a Rotarian in the North Delta Rotary Club, a board member of the Centre for Child Development, and part of the off-ice officials team for the Surrey Eagles Junior A Hockey team.

Ken has also been a major contributor to KPU and its students, having served six years on the Board of Kwantlen University College, including one year as chair. More recently, he served for many years on the board of the KPU Foundation, including a number of years as chair.

Ken remains as a trustee and board member for the BC Credit Union Employees Pension and Benefit Trust.



### Mary Mikelson

To say Mary Mikelson is an arts advocate is an understatement. A passionate and dedicated woman, Mary and her late husband Arnold created the Mind and Matter Gallery over 45 years ago. Since first opening its doors, over 7,000 artists have had their work shown in the space, and Mary is credited with helping many up-and-coming artists reach their potential.

In 1973, Mary and Arnold expanded their love and appreciation for arts and culture, launching the first annual Arnold Mikelson Festival of the Arts. That same year they designed Arts 101: Introduction to the Visual Arts for children program—teaching visiting classes of children about art appreciation and creativity.

To honour her unwavering dedication to the arts and culture sector in Surrey, Mary was presented with the Surrey Civic Treasure in Award in 2008.

In 2012 she received the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal and has also been the recipient of the Order of White Rock for outstanding community service. She was awarded the Province of British Columbia Certificate of Beauty and Enlightenment, and has received numerous awards and certificates of appreciation for her work in the arts community.

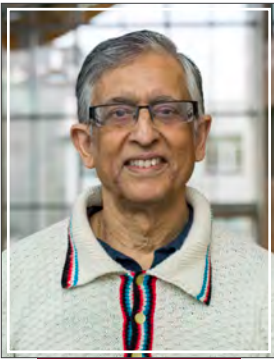

## Distinguished Teaching Award, Full-time Category



**Dr. Abhijit Sen**

Dr. Abhijit Sen has over 30 years of academic and administrative experience at KPU, including 14 years as the chair of the Computer Science and Information Technology department. He was instrumental in the development and launch of the Bachelor of Technology in Information Technology degree at KPU, and developed joint academic initiatives for international student exchanges between Canada and the European Union with the Consortium on Computer Networks and Network Security studies program. He was also a member of a delegation to Cuba to review IT training and education for the Ministry of Education, and provided workshops abroad.

Wanting his students to be committed and engaged in their studies, Abhijit has tailored his assignments to emphasize hands-on learning, research and critical thinking. As a result, his students have become exceptional leaders in their chosen fields.

As a professional leader himself, Abhijit has chaired numerous conferences and presented many keynote addresses. He is a life member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, and represented the Vancouver chapter as section chair of the Life Member's Affinity Group. Abhijit was a national council member of the Information Systems and Technology Accreditation Council of the Canadian Information Society, and was involved both as a member and team leader of several accreditation teams that review computing programs of different institutions in Canada.

Abhijit has also served as an external examiner for PhD theses at various universities. His current interests in research include wireless networking and security, radio frequency identification, computing education and teaching methodologies, and distributed systems. He is currently a faculty member within the KPU School of Business and has been invited as a visiting professor at several universities in other countries, including New Zealand, India, Germany, and China.

A researcher, mentor, academic and psychology instructor, Dr. Daniel Bernstein has been active in the KPU community for over a decade. Known as a “go-to” person when it comes to developing research ideas, designing projects, running statistics, interpreting results and providing feedback, Daniel’s outstanding reputation among students and colleagues alike is evident.

He has published with many other influential individuals in some of the most highly regarded academic journals and publications in the field, and continues to share his knowledge and guidance in KPU’s psychology honours program. Daniel remains committed to KPU—attending events, participating on numerous committees, and organizing and participating in conferences that provide opportunities to students both here and at other institutions.

Daniel continues to run a highly active student research lab at KPU (Lifespan Cognition Lab) and many students who have worked in the lab regularly credit Daniel’s guidance and mentorship as a crucial element in their successes.

Daniel’s demonstrated excellence in his field was further underscored in 2013 when he received a Canada Research Chair Tier II award to study lifespan cognition, a first for KPU. In 2014 he was named a member of the Royal Society of Canada’s College of New Scholars, Artists, and Scientists.

## Distinguished Service Award, Teaching Category



**Judy Lee**

Judy Lee has been a faculty member at KPU for nearly three decades.

She has been an integral part of curriculum changes, seeing the nursing program evolve from a diploma to degree. She co-ordinated and developed clinical practice placements for the entire Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program locally, nationally, and internationally. She has worked with the Inter-professional Rural Program of BC and the First Nations Health Authority, placing students in northern B.C. and acting as a preceptor for masters' students focusing on nursing education.

Judy has also made important contributions to the design sessions for development of the Health Sciences Placement Network (HSPnet), a database used nationally and internationally to support practice education. While representing KPU, she was the first person to log into HSPnet. Additionally, Judy took the lead in creating and working with a multidisciplinary group at BC Children's Hospital and the Fraser Health Authority on a research and program development project related to youth violence, which included contributions from KPU students and faculty.

Judy received the Award of Excellence with distinction for her contribution to education at BC Children's Hospital (including Sunny Hill Health Centre) and BC Women's Hospital & Health Centre. The award was given for her work on *Youth to Youth Violence: Working Together to Care for Youth and Families*.

As the chair of the BSN program at KPU, Judy has been instrumental in establishing a structure for the registration, scheduling and clinical placement processes. She has supported the work of the BSN Curriculum, Admissions and Progressions committees and created a supportive educational environment for the next generation of nurses.

Maureen's thorough knowledge of admissions, registration and student records has made her an expert and department go-to for others and her participation and passion extends to the numerous committees and activities.

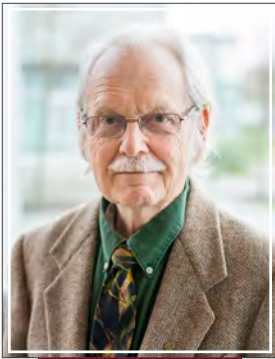

## Professor Emeritus



### Dr. Warren Bourgeois

Starting at KPU in the early 1980s as the only member of the university's philosophy department, Warren Bourgeois single-handedly kept the department running for several years and his continued contributions have not gone unnoticed.

Warren helped to craft the basic curriculum outline for the philosophy program, which is still the foundation of what is in use today. He was vital to the establishment of KPU's policy studies program, served on the University Program Review Committee, spearheaded the first philosophy program review, and sat on the Research Ethics Board for seven years, during which time he was also chair.

His dedication and commitment to his field and to sharing his knowledge has benefitted others across the university and in the local community. Warren actively mentors other colleagues, has written and co-authored two books, has been published in several highly prestigious journals, and has helped to organize and speak at numerous conferences. He was a consultant for the formation of an Ethics Committee at Surrey Memorial Hospital, served on the committee itself, and now continues to work in a consulting role.

Although he is now retired, Warren is still deeply connected to KPU, producing valuable materials to help others teaching in the same discipline, leading presentations, and sharing the valuable insights he has gained throughout his impressive and extensive career.

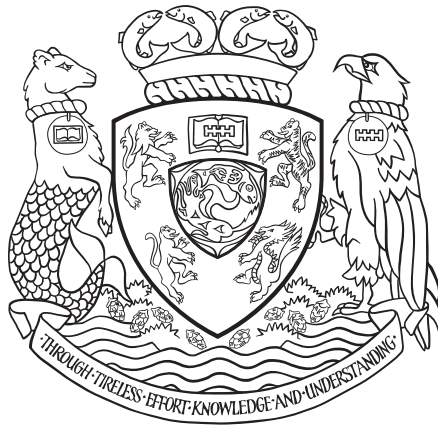

# *Convocation Traditions*

## Heraldry



The Arms of Kwantlen Polytechnic University were presented at a ceremony on May 4, 1999 by the Right Honourable Romeo LeBlanc, Governor General of Canada.

The centre shield features "The Spirit of KPU" emblem comprising a wolf, a salmon, and a river azure as styled by Brandon Gabriel.

At the top of the blue shield, on the left side a lion and on the right a tiger facing each other in the rampant position (upright on one hind leg with forelegs outstretched as if attacking). And at the bottom of the blue shield, on the left a jaguar and on the right a Chinese dragon also facing each other in the rampant position. All are gold.

At the top in the centre, there is an open book with silver or white pages, bindings in gold and on top of it, a gold horizontal (in fess) rectangle (billet) with square bites taken out of the long sides (bretessed). In modern heraldry, this item is meant to represent a computer chip.

The crest appears above the shield, and is supported by a silver and blue twisted fabric wreath. The upper rim is set with a simple silver crown, the upper edge decorated with four salmon, looking at each other in pairs.

Supporting the arms is a green grassy mound, scattered with gold Douglas Fir cones. The mound is rising from wavy horizontal bands of blue and silver. This is the traditional heraldic representation of water - either river or ocean.

On the left is a gold female deer with blue hooves, and her bottom half is a silver fishtail with gold fins. Around her neck is a wreath of twisted silver and blue cloth. Hanging from the wreath is a green disk with an open book on it—the pages are silver; the cover is gold.

On the right is a gold eagle with a silver head, with blue talons and beak. Around his neck is a wreath like the doe's and hanging from it is a green disk with the heraldic representation of a gold computer chip.

The motto reads: Through Tireless Effort, Knowledge and Understanding.

## University Mace



The mace was originally a weapon during the medieval period, and came to be associated with the prowess and strength of the knight. Today the mace is a symbol of the University's authority to award degrees and diplomas. It indicates the seriousness of convocation as the University's most important academic ceremony, and is a confirmation of the University's integrity as an academic institution. The mace is carried by a mace-bearer, who leads the processional of faculty and students in to and out of the venue where

convocation is held. The mace is usually between 120 cm and 180 cm in length and will incorporate the history and tradition that surround the vision for the University.

An academic mace symbolizes the authority vested in the chancellor to confer University credentials. This is why the mace is an integral part of convocation.

Maces are often commissioned to commemorate a milestone anniversary or presidential inauguration. Typically an artist is selected for the honour to develop a highly symbolic design that incorporates the University's traditions.

KPU's mace was carved by Kwantlen First Nation artist Drew Atkins.





# Regalia

Not until they slip into their regalia, do many graduands realize the significance of their convocation ceremony. For family and friends, the first glimpse of the graduand in cap and gown heralds a milestone in the life of their loved one.

## Standard for Academic Dress

At KPU, all graduates wear a black gown of Oxford shape and a black cap with a black tassel. Graduates of our bachelor's degree programs wear hoods in the Aberdeen style, made of black pilgrim cloth and bordered with a one half inch border. The border of each hood is a specific colour that identifies a particular area of study.

- Bachelor of Applied Arts in Psychology: Black hood with winter white border
- Bachelor of Science in Applied Psychology: Black hood with winter white border

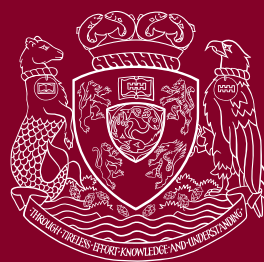
