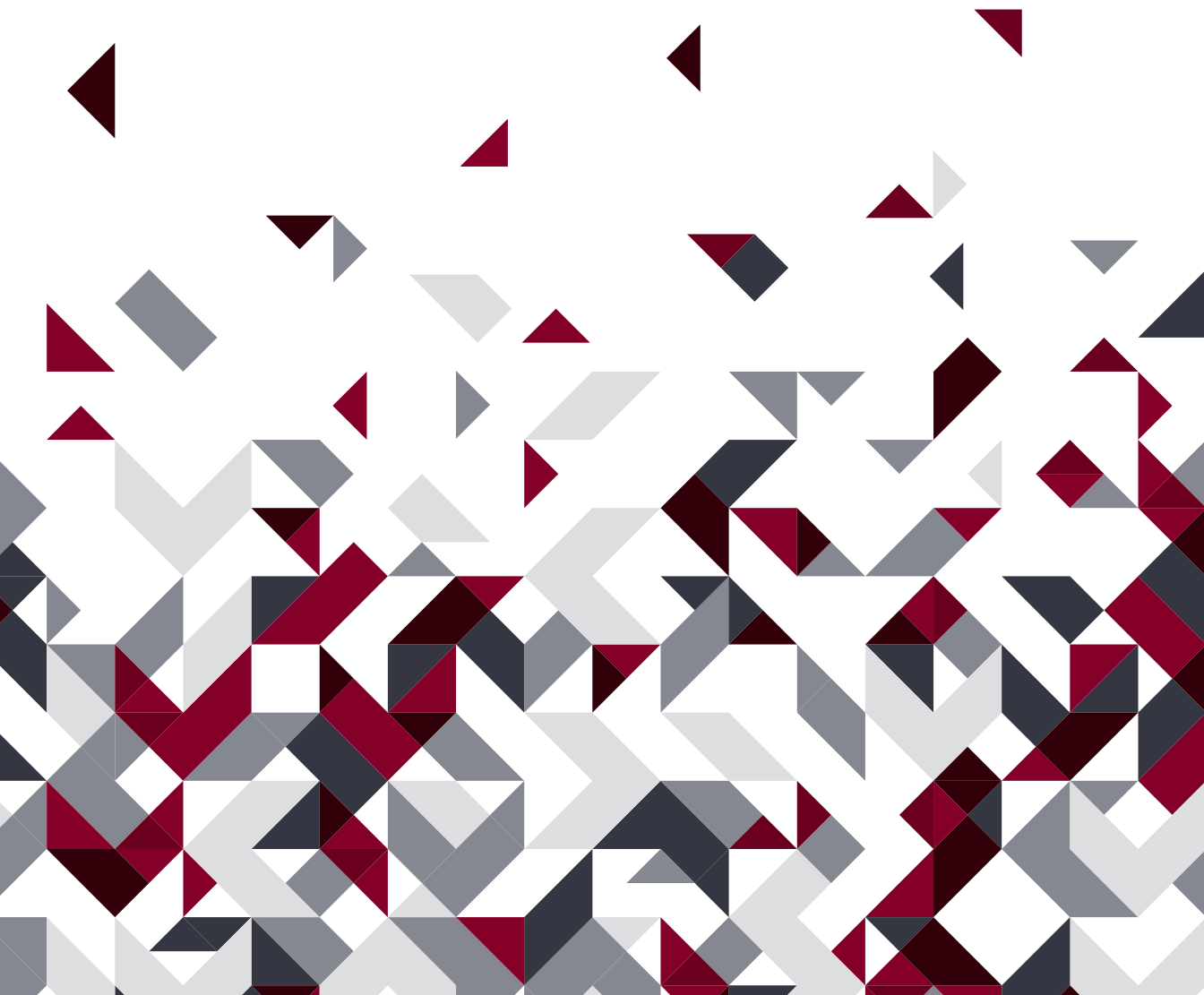

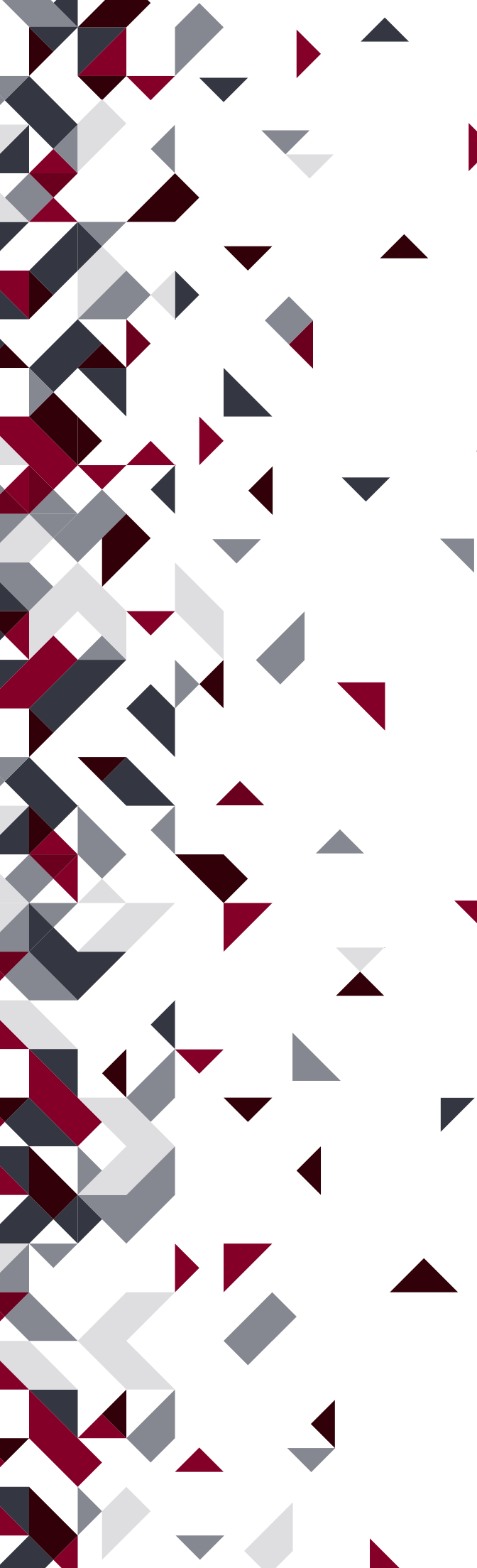

Six months before his 24th birthday, Mr. Byrnes had a life-altering accident that caused him to lose both of his legs. Undeterred, he continued to pursue his music career and by 1982, he was a common act on the Vancouver music scene.

Mr. Byrnes is a legendary Blues music icon having recorded 11 albums from 1981 to 2017. He has won three JUNO Awards for Blues Album of the Year (1996, 2007 and 2011). He is also a winner of the Maple Blues Awards (2006 male vocalist of the year) and Canadian Folk Music Awards (2006 and 2009 Contemporary Vocalist of the Year).

As an actor, Mr. Byrnes is very well known nationally and internationally appearing in dozens of film, television and animation projects since 1980. These include shows like Wiseguy, Highlander: The Series, Highlander: Endgame, X-Men: Evolution, to name a few. In 1993, he was nominated for a Genie for Best Actor in a Supporting Role for his work in Harmony Cats, and in 1996 won the Leo for Best Actor in a TV Drama for his work in Highlander.

Mr. Byrnes is also a committed humanitarian and philanthropist. He is a founding member of Face the World, helping to raise funds for many deserving charities. He's a member of Variety – The Children's Charity and is on the board of the Odd Squad Production Society, a charitable organization recognized as a leader in the field of drug and gang education of youth. Many more organizations have benefitted by Mr. Byrnes philanthropic efforts over the years – such as Vancouver Food Bank, The Sunny Hill Health Centre at BC Children's Hospital, Vancouver Adaptive Music Society, Canuck Place, AIDS Vancouver, and Burnaby Firefighters Charitable Society. His commitment in bettering the lives of people is notable and commendable.



Kathy Kinloch

Kathy Kinloch has had a dedicated and extensive career in public service, including leadership positions in health, government and post-secondary education. She began her career as a trained nurse and ascended through the health sector to becoming the Chief Operating Officer of Fraser Health, before becoming Senior Advisor for the BC Ministry of Health where she established the UBC Hospital Centre for Surgical Innovation. In 2007 Ms. Kinloch transitioned to post-secondary education and became the Dean, School of Health Sciences at British Columbia Institute of Technology and in 2010 she was the President of Vancouver Community College. From 2014 until her retirement, Ms. Kinloch was the President of the British Columbia Institute of Technology.

Ms. Kinloch has been devoted to student success. She demonstrated passion for training students through polytechnic applied education, strengthening relationships with business and industry to ensure programming is relevant and meaningful and by doing so, supported the province's need for job-ready graduates who can feed directly into in-demand occupations. Her most recent notable career accomplishment is successfully advocating and receiving government funding for a \$163M Trades and Technology Complex at BCIT's Burnaby campus, which will help get more students into skilled trades and support our province's economic recovery and growth into the future.

Kathy's leadership track record extends beyond post-secondary. In her senior leadership and executive roles, she has led strategic change initiatives in government and healthcare. She has a long history of accolades and accomplishments to her name, having been named a Woman of Distinction by the YWCA Metro Vancouver, one of Canada's 100 Most Powerful Women by the Women's Executive Network, and one of the 50 most influential women in British Columbia by Vancouver Magazine, Award of Merit, Health Employers Association of BC, and Honorary Doctor of Laws from Royal Roads University.

Ms. Kinloch has led an extraordinary career, earning herself a reputation for transformational leadership in support of the betterment of society – clearly demonstrated through her time in health care and higher education.

DISTINGUISHED TEACHING AWARD, FULL-TIME

Outstanding teaching is a core element of KPU and, accordingly, the University recognizes and celebrates outstanding examples of teaching. The KPU Award for Distinguished Teaching is intended to recognize remarkable teaching as demonstrated by activities such as the development of new courses and curricula, contributions to the scholarship of teaching, development of effective teaching methods, enrichment of the learning environment at KPU, and contributions that improve the teaching of colleagues.



John Shepherd

For over twenty years, John Shepherd has been teaching undergraduate business courses and has been with KPU since 2009. He has instructed a range of courses in Introductory Financial Accounting, Intermediate Financial Accounting, Advanced Financial Accounting, Introductory and Advanced Management Accounting, Financial Management, Accounting Theory, Not-for-Profit Accounting, and Entrepreneurial Finance.

John is being recognized with this award for his contribution that improved the teaching of colleagues and aided student mastery of complex topics in Financial Accounting and Finance courses. In particular, John led the Accounting Department during and post-pandemic in developing test banks in Moodle that greatly improved academic integrity controls.

John is an enthusiastic and dedicated instructor. He utilizes a variety of methods to engage students in the information. He uses real-life examples to demonstrate concepts, slides, graphs, and videos. He also provides external resources for students to review alternate explanations of theories. He views his role as providing students with the tools and background knowledge to successfully adapt to a constantly changing, uncertain world. He wants his students to think for themselves, ask challenging questions, and to think through the implications of their decisions. Instead of viewing the world in black and white, he encourages students to accept the grey and have the courage to make decisions in the face of uncertainty based on their personal values and organization needs.

John has an active contributor within KPU's research community. His writings have been published in a variety of academic venues, articles in academic journals, business case studies, sample marketing plans in marketing textbooks, and a chapter in a community service-learning book.

Kim McGill

Kim McGill's service to KPU, its employees and students, has been extraordinary for the past 21 years. She has dedicated her career at KPU to serving the institution well beyond all the roles she has held. People who have worked with her say she is a true leader, mentor, focused, and knows how to bring people together to ensure the success of whatever project or initiative she is working on.

In her first eleven years at KPU, Kim held the role as Instructional Associate for the Faculty of Academic and Career Advancement (ACA). For her work instructing and arranging work placements for students with multiple disabilities and barriers, Kim was honoured with the Kwantlen University College Celebration of Excellence Award for Teaching Excellence. She was a voting member and Vice Chair of the ACA Faculty Council, Chair of the ACA Nomination & Governance Committee, and creator of the Access Programs for People with Disabilities (APPD) Alumni Network.

In 2012, she held the role as Instructional Associate Coordinator for APPD, and represented Professional Support staff on the KPU Senate from 2012 – 2015. She was also a member of the Senate Executive Committee and the Senate Standing Committee on Policy Review. As well, she served as the Marketing Coordinator and Chaired the Marketing Committee for ACA.

In 2014, Kim was seconded as Operations Manager for ACA, leading the Administrative support staff, advisors, and tutors. In 2015, she was elected to represent Professional Support Staff on the KPU Board of Governors which she proudly served until 2021.

In 2017, Kim moved to the role as Manager of Communications and Technologies in the Future Students' Office (FSO). She worked tirelessly for KPU and her team and built valuable relationships to transform the department and instilled a new level of collaboration with other internal areas.

In August 2020, she was charged with launching a new department under the Office of External Affairs. As the Manager of Community Engagement and Major Events, Kim defined a new portfolio for herself and her two direct reports. She built bridges with the new teams – including Alumni, Advancement, Government Relations and the KPU Foundation – while assisting with the smooth transition of FSO events to Student Services. With all the unknowns facing them, Kim maintained morale and encouraged her team to learn, grow and face the challenges with enthusiasm.

Kim also dedicates herself to bolstering morale, engagement, and inclusivity within KPU. She served on multiple committees, including the Employee Engagement Working Group, the Disability Inclusion Group's subcommittee on inclusive events, and lead the formalization of safe, inclusive event protocols at KPU.

External to KPU, Kim has been a member of the City of Surrey Measuring Up Committee, and the Foundation of Excellence Transition Committee. She provided consulting/business development services to the *Now Newspaper*, co-managing their Charity Golf Tournament. At the *Now*, Kim created a new publication, *PossAbilities* providing a forum for discussion of disability-related issues. For this work, she was the 2012 Gold Recipient of the Ma Murray Award from the BC/Yukon Community Newspaper Association. Kim continues to be very active in the City of Surrey, volunteering for many events, including the Annual Mayor's Golf Tournament and Gala. Kim's community work dovetails with her KPU roles and has allowed her to advocate for learners while creating connections that have raised the profile of KPU throughout the region.

The KPU mission reads: By thinking and acting together, we transform lives and empower positive change. Kim has lived this mission since her first day at KPU. She works endlessly to ensure the KPU experience is positive for all. She works to delight all KPU friends. She embraces change, sustainability and culture, she is an expert at creative problem solving and she holds herself, and her team accountable for their work.

Todd Mundle

Todd Mundle has been KPU's University Librarian since 2012 and has demonstrated consistently his exemplary leadership skills that seem to be completely natural to him. Both the Library and KPU have benefitted from Todd's outstanding leadership. His contributions extend to many departments, have direct impact on the KPU student experience, and positively reflect KPU values.

In particular, Todd's leadership in keeping the Library open throughout the pandemic facilitated KPU's transition to virtual instruction and ensured that students had the space and resources required to complete their studies. In an uncertain period of time, Todd faced challenges head on and displayed resiliency in finding solutions to issues and problems. His willingness to go the extra mile if need be, could be counted on and his staff always knew that they were supported and he had their backs. His physical presence, helpfulness, problem-solving ability and knowledge were beneficial during those difficult times.

Todd's leadership in securing funding and adapting policy moved the Library forward. He progressively adjusted budgets, quickly pivoting collection funds to meet the overnight growth in demand for digital content, while advocating for budgets to support new endeavours. He managed all of this while staying focused on the various KPU Library Strategic Plan goals, including Indigenization and instructional support.

Todd has been a true champion of the Library and KPU's world-renowned Open Education initiatives. He always looks for new and innovative ways in which the Library can provide free resources to students, and supports his team in working towards truly Open Education.

Todd's leadership with regards to Truth and Reconciliation is evidenced by his outstanding commitment to KPU's Vision 2023 in making the University and Library a more inclusive space for Indigenous Peoples and Indigenous research. He reduces barriers, opens doors, and breaks the glass ceiling when it comes to Indigenization, such as identifying and promoting Indigenous voices in the library collections and developing an Indigenous Resource Hub.

His staff view him as an exceptional leader and consider him a decent and caring human being. He prioritizes human needs, both in the goals of the Library's service to the KPU community, and in his management style. He is approachable, open-minded, non-judgmental, compassionate, and has a great deal of integrity. He encourages and empowers his staff to develop professionally and gives them the time, tools and resources to do so.

Todd was instrumental in keeping morale and engagement up in a very isolating and stressful time, not just for his own staff, but all KPU employees. He planned various team-building activities for his staff that were conducted both remotely and on-campus and participated in KPU Engage that provided a variety of activities and venues intended to

keep all KPU employees engaged. In fact, the KPU Engage Team is also being recognized for a 2022 Team Service Award of which Todd is an active member.

Todd is physically very active and has inspired many to increase their own activity and improve their health. As an avid supporter of the broader community, Todd has helped to raise thousands of dollars by participating in efforts such as the Tour de Cure, Coldest Night of the Year, and United Way's UPS Plain Pull of a Boeing 757.

Todd is an active member of many KPU and other professional committees, often serving as Chair or Co-Chair. He is currently President of the British Columbia Library Association. His contributions on committees have benefitted the academic library world across Canada and have given the KPU Library valuable information and contacts.

For these reasons and many more, we are honoured and proud to award Todd Mundle the 2022 Distinguished Leadership Award.

KPU Engage

In May 2020, in response to the sudden upheaval of the pandemic and shift to social distancing measures and remote work, several faculty members, support staff, and administrative employees (members of KPU's four employee engagement work groups) met online to brainstorm ideas that would foster employees' feelings of connection and belonging in this exceptional time of need.

This led to the formation of three Engage sub-committees dedicated to enhancing the well-being of their colleagues: Opportunities to Socialize (Meredith Laird [Chair], Josephine Chan, Jennifer Jordan, Jessie Malli, Tammy Hulstra, Todd Mundle, Triona King, Wade Deisman), Projects/Learning based Clubs (Teresa Smith [Chair], Jennifer Jordan, Meredith Laird, Isabel Chan, Christine He), and Communication and Connection (Christine He [Chair], Christina Shorthouse, Kristy Grimston, Sarah Duncan). These sub-committees met frequently through summer of 2020 to flesh out various ideas. KPU Engage Virtual Happy Breaks officially launched in September

2020 with the intention of bringing employees across KPU together through online events and ensuring no one felt socially isolated, particularly those individuals who live alone.

Over the next few months events expanded to include Sport and Recreation virtual workouts, KPU Jeopardy, Ted Talks Tuesdays, Skill Share events on topics such as Robert's Rules and minute taking, and KPU Cooks cooking club. The wildly successful events were promoted with enthusiasm by the Communication and Connection sub-committee and more and more employees were wanting to contribute more ideas for activities and events. In November 2020, Dr. David Burns launched "Notes from Exile: Strange Conversations at a Strange Time". This was a five-and-a-half-episode special video series where Dr. Burns interviewed different employees from across the institution with the goal of helping employees get to know one another. In late 2020, the Communications and Connection sub-committee put a call out for KPU Engage Champions to help spread the word about KPU Virtual Happy Breaks and this led to the recruitment of department champions from International (Sydney Munro), the Future Students' Office (Sheri Browning) and the Career Development Centre (Liyana Johan Amilin) who regularly met with the Communication and Connection sub-committee to exchange ideas.

Moving into 2021 as feedback was sought and ideas grew, more activities were offered like the weekly Employee Lounge, the Meowmy cat club and a virtual travel club. The sub-committees felt it was important that employees hear from their leaders at this critical time and began hosting Executive Member Interviews. Throughout the spring and summer, the formation of a new arts enthusiast's club, KPU GLAM (Galleries, Libraries, Archives and Museums) was launched.

The efforts of KPU Engage were never more evident when we saw the results from the 2021 Employee Survey. This survey demonstrated that employee engagement increased 19% from 2018 to 2021.

In its first year of activities, KPU Engage had 18 dedicated committee members, organized 135 activity sessions and contributed 92.75 hours of their own time.

KPU Engage helped employees stay connected and it is one of the many reasons why KPU is recognized as one of BC's Top Employers in 2022. Research shows that strong social connections make people happier and physically healthier, which can translate into work performance. Employees with social connections at work tend to be more engaged. To date, KPU Engage has continued to offer a variety of activities for employees to come together virtually and to get to know one another. Their efforts have minimized the separation of KPU's campuses, introduced new employees, as well as old, helped forge new friendships and enhanced existing ones, boosted employee morale and supported those most in need of connections with others.

PRESIDENT'S OUTSTANDING GRADUATE AWARD

Presented annually, the President's Outstanding Graduate Award encourages KPU students to excel in their chosen fields of study and to participate in university, student and community activities to the benefit of others. Recipients have completed all their study in one program at KPU, have consistently shown outstanding ability in the field, have contributed in a significant way to KPU or community affairs, and may be recommended by faculty.

Aside from her school work, Dominique has many hobbies and interests such as hiking, cooking, exercising, learning new languages, playing board games, music and reading. Her favourite music genres are Math Rock, Vapourwave, and French Posttrigodon.

Included in her spare time, Dominique has also volunteered a great deal at KPU. As a volunteer for the Student Orientation and Transition Team, she logged 143 volunteer hours since the Spring of 2018. She also was the only French tutor at KPU's Learning Centre. Dominique has also supported students with disabilities through

Assessment and Testing Services as a peer note-taker, reader, orator and scribe. Through all of her volunteer activities, she is commended for her commitment to diversity and equity, professionalism, and leadership skills. She approaches everything and every challenge with dedication and enthusiasm.

Academically, Dominique's performance in the classroom and her studies has consistently been high. Since May 2022 she was engaged as an undergraduate researcher within the Institute for Sustainable Horticulture. 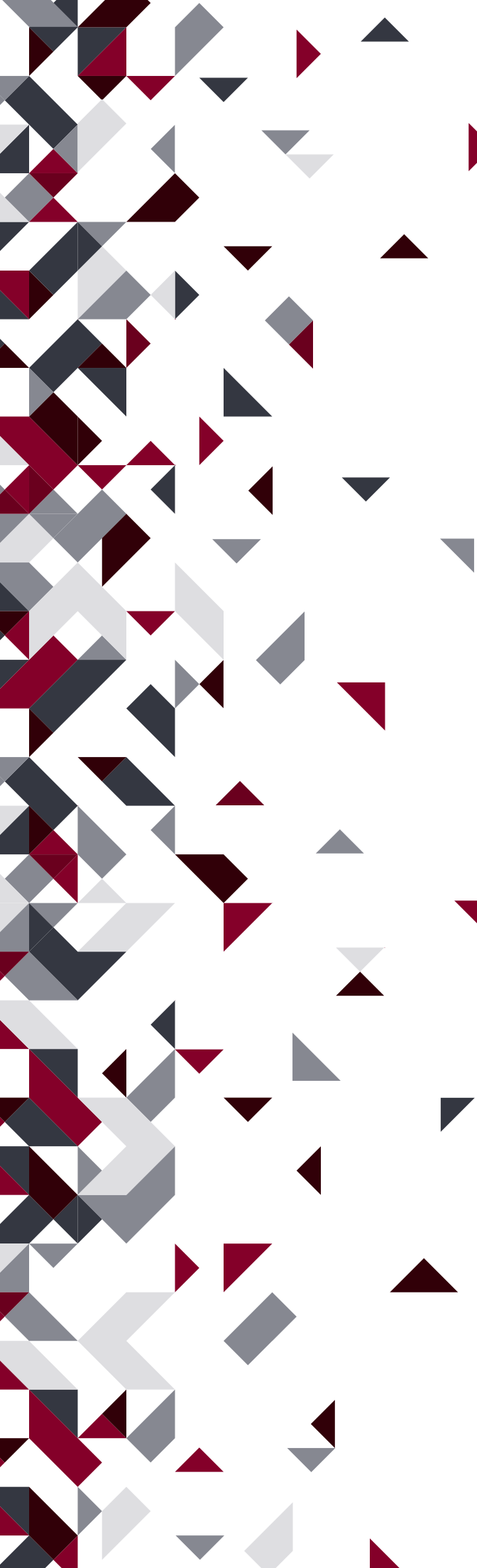

CONVOCATION TRADITIONS



KWANTLEN POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY

HERALDRY

The Arms of Kwantlen Polytechnic University were presented at a ceremony on May 4, 1999 by the Right Honourable Romeo LeBlanc, Governor General of Canada.

The centre shield features ‘The Spirit of KPU’ emblem comprising a wolf, a salmon, and a river azure as styled by Brandon Gabriel.

At the top of the blue shield, on the left side a lion and on the right a tiger facing each other in the rampant position (upright on one hind leg with forelegs outstretched as if attacking). And at the bottom of the blue shield, on the left a jaguar and on the right a Chinese dragon also facing each other in the rampant position. All are gold.

At the top in the centre, there is an open book with silver or white pages, bindings in gold and on top of it, a gold horizontal (in fess) rectangle (billet) with square bites taken out of the long sides (bretessed). In modern heraldry, this item is meant to represent a computer chip.

The crest appears above the shield, and is supported by a silver and blue twisted fabric wreath. The upper rim is set with a simple silver crown, the upper edge decorated with four salmon, looking at each other in pairs.

Supporting the arms is a green grassy mound, scattered with gold Douglas Fir cones. The mound is rising from wavy horizontal bands of blue and silver. This is the traditional heraldic representation of water - either river or ocean.

On the left is a gold female deer with blue hooves, and her bottom half is a silver fishtail with gold fins. Around her neck is a wreath of twisted silver and blue cloth. Hanging from the wreath is a green disk with an open book on it—the pages are silver; the cover is gold.

On the right is a gold eagle with a silver head, with blue talons and beak. Around his neck is a wreath like the doe’s and hanging from it is a green disk with the heraldic representation of a gold computer chip.

The motto reads: Through Tireless Effort, Knowledge and Understanding.

UNIVERSITY MACE



The mace was originally a weapon during the medieval period, and came to be associated with the prowess and strength of the knight. Today the mace is a symbol of the University’s authority to award degrees and diplomas. It indicates the seriousness of convocation as the University’s most important academic ceremony, and is a confirmation of the University’s integrity as an academic institution. The mace is carried by a mace-bearer, who leads the processional of faculty and students in to and out of the venue where convocation is held. The mace is usually between four feet and six feet in length and will incorporate the history and tradition that surround the vision for the University.

An academic mace symbolizes the authority vested in the chancellor to confer university credentials. This is why the mace is an integral part of convocation.

Maces are often commissioned to commemorate a milestone anniversary or presidential inauguration. Typically an artist is selected for the honour to develop a highly symbolic design that incorporates the University’s traditions.

KPU’s mace was carved by Kwantlen First Nation artist Drew Atkins.

REGALIA

Not until they slip into their regalia, do many graduands realize the significance of their convocation ceremony. For family and friends, the first glimpse of the graduand in cap and gown heralds a milestone in the life of their loved one.
