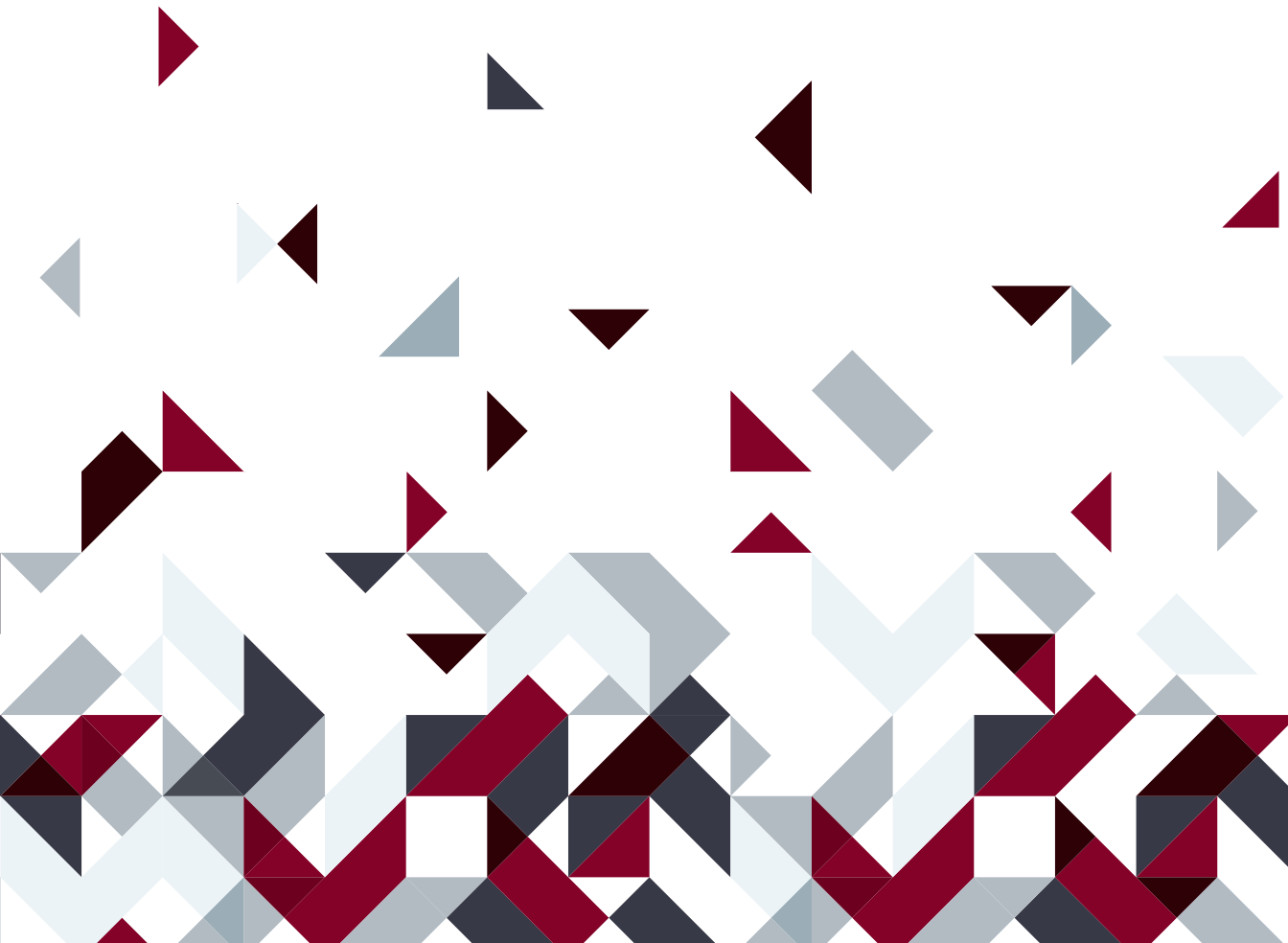

AWARD RECIPIENTS

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD, FACULTY DIVISION

Distinguished Service Awards honour and recognize exceptional, long-standing service to KPU and/or the educational community that KPU serves. The receipt of this award will bring honour and distinction to KPU as well as to the recipient.



Dr. Alice Macpherson

For over 40 years, Dr. Macpherson's career has been focused on education – both teaching students and teachers. In 1993 she began as a faculty member in continuing education and eventually moved to the Teaching and Learning Centre or Academic Growth as a Learning Strategist.

Her vision as a faculty member, instructor and facilitator is to support and encourage learning that is personally transforming and that has a positive and valued impact on the individual. She constantly adapts methods to do this through facilitative direct contact, distance connections, and by encouraging collateral learning whenever it fits the learner needs. Dr. Macpherson espouses that this collaborative learning change is intended to be socially responsible within the community that is shared and personally useful to the individual.

Dr. Macpherson developed and implemented a Teaching for Learning program with a specific focus towards supporting new faculty colleagues entering the teaching profession and on grounding their future teaching in good, evidence-based practices that support student learning. The 70-hour curriculum includes the Instructional Skills Workshop, Portfolio Development, Managing Classrooms, Cooperative Learning, Formative and Summative Assessments, as well as working with Educational Technology, Learning Management Systems, and a variety of academic resources.

In the Learning Centre, she was the lead in developing a three-level curriculum for Peer Tutors that included 25 hours of training and development at each level. Further, she led the organization and accreditation of this curriculum through the Educational Developers Cause of the Society for Teaching and Learning in Higher Education, and has been a member of the training team that held 15 training sessions sharing this material at universities and colleges across Canada.

Dr. Macpherson's skills and expertise has benefitted a great number of faculty and staff at KPU. People who participated in her workshops say their teaching practices benefitted significantly. Others say that working with her has helped them in their own growth and development. Dr. Macpherson is known to be an excellent communicator, empathetic listener, and really works at trying to understand the other person. Her colleagues emphatically agree that they've all been greatly enriched by Dr. Macpherson, and in this way, she deserves to be acknowledged for this award.

DISTINGUISHED SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Exemplary teaching is a core element of KPU, and scholarship in its diverse forms is integral to that endeavour: the scholarship of discovery, creativity, application, teaching and learning, and integration. Accordingly, KPU recognizes and celebrates outstanding examples of such scholarship.



Dr. Asma Sayed

Dr. Asma Sayed is one of Canada's leading scholars in South Asian Literary and Cultural Studies, with an internationally recognized profile for excellence in academic research, scholarship, and publishing. Her work has been recognized with a Tier II Canada Research Chair (CRC) in South Asian Literary and Cultural Studies, and induction into the Royal Society of Canada's College of New Scholars, Scientists, and Artists. Her research covers an astounding breadth and has made significant contributions to feminist, postcolonial, literary, and media scholarship around the world.

Aside from an awe-inspiring list of publications and conferences - five edited books; three online course books; dozens of peer-reviewed and public-facing articles reviews and book chapters and creative non-fiction pieces; and over 100 conference presentations, invited talks and keynotes. Dr. Sayed continually mobilizes her knowledge and training in order to mentor colleagues, create opportunities for students, and act in service within and beyond the academic community. She is the

Chair of the English Department's Research and Scholarship Committee and an active member of the Faculty of Arts' Research and Scholarship Committee. She is also a member of the KPU Social Justice Centre, the Arts Faculty and International Student Success Committee and the English Department's Library Committee. Through her leadership, Dr. Sayed advocates for KPU researchers and models the multitude of ways that scholarship can inform and intersect with pedagogy, mentorship, collaboration, and community engagement.

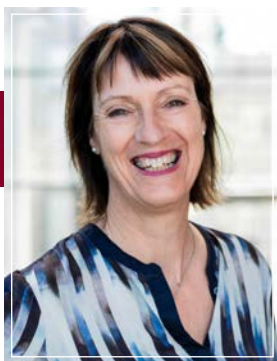
Over the next five years Dr. Sayed will continue to expand and deepen research at KPU as a Canada Research Chair. Her research program includes a monograph, a multilingual anthology, and a digital portal that will serve as an archive and open-access teaching and research tool. Her research will inform her curriculum development, pedagogy, service, and community engagement, and continue to create opportunities for students and faculty.

Dr. Sayed is committed to student involvement in her scholarship overseeing a team of Student Research Assistants and mentoring them as they engage in research and collaborative scholarly publications and presentations. She also put considerable effort into securing additional external funds and expanding KPU's research profile, applying as an individual for a Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada (SSHRC) Insight grant and as a Project Co-Director for SSHRC Race, Gender and Diversity Initiative Grant.

Over the last couple of years, Dr. Sayed has also drawn on her expertise to expand and deepen her service at KPU, particularly in the field of Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion (EDI) with a focus on anti-racism. As the leader of KPU's Task Force on Anti-Racism (TFA), she has coordinated eight workshops and events; liaised with departments, faculties, committees, and non-academic support units across campus; and consulted on the development of EDI/anti-racism policies and surveys. She also joined the Task Force on EDI in Research and Scholarship, and regularly attended Indigenous Advisory Council and the President's Diversity and Equity Committee meetings. Dr. Sayed's research and informal knowledge dissemination have been foundations for institutional change, and she continues to lead KPU towards a more just and equitable future.

DISTINGUISHED LEADERSHIP AWARD

Distinguished Service Awards honour and recognize exceptional, long-standing service to KPU and/or the educational community that KPU serves. The receipt of this award will bring honour and distinction to KPU as well as to the recipient.



Dr. Diane Purvey

Dr. Diane Purvey is an inspirational leader – she leads by example but is unparalleled in her will to lead, mentor and support others. She is trusted and well respected, authentic, intentional and empathetic towards the diverse needs of students and faculty. She takes the time to get to know the strengths of those around her, exhibits care and compassion, and demonstrates a genuine passion for and skill in connecting people. She does not exude a shred of hubris and time and time again will give praise and attention to others when it is she who should be receiving the praise.

Dr. Purvey works tirelessly in service of KPU – its students, its faculty, and its broader profile and placement in the community. Her initiatives are countless, spanning all levels of potential influence and extending well into our local communities.

At the institutional level, Dr. Purvey proposed the formalization of the Council of Deans, struck the Arts Research and Scholarship Committee, and is a respected voice on President's Council and Academic Council. On a curricular level, Dr. Purvey

has supported the indigenization of course offerings through such initiatives as the development of a course in hən'q'əmin'əm', advocated for the development of Arts Research-intensive courses supporting student-faculty research collaborations, developed the Arts 1100 courses – multidisciplinary explorations of common themes, supported the development of Amazon Interdisciplinary Field School, and won the 2018 award for Open Education.

At the faculty level, Dr. Purvey is always present to support innovation and achievement, and always contributes where she can. Faculty consider her to be an exemplary leader who is open, curious, a strong active listener, a clear and engaged communicator and ethical. When she makes a decision, her rationale is clear – and even if the decision may not fall the way a department or individual wants it to, the rationale is always sound and the delivery of the rationale always compassionate and insightful. In fact, her leadership style makes it easy for others to take on leadership roles as well. Being open, approachable and resourceful, faculty routinely reach out to Dr. Purvey for support and sage advice around teaching, research and career endeavors.

Dr. Purvey is never afraid to raise difficult issues or bring another perspective to the table and, in doing so, she models courageous and compassionate leadership. Encouraging dialogue is a major tenet of her leadership style and ensures that everyone's voice is heard. This is particularly evident in her sincere passion to support the work of the Anti-Racism Task Force and other initiatives related to equity, diversity and inclusion.

It is with great honour, admiration and gratitude that KPU awards this newly created Distinguished Leadership Award to Dr. Diane Purvey.

The International Advising Team is far more than just a team, and the way this team works is a model for all to aspire. The International Advising Team has been selected to receive the very first Team Service Award for its significant contributions towards the mission and goals of KPU, and amazingly, their work has been conducted under pandemic restrictions and complications.

The Team's continuous improvement, highest standards of professionalism, commitment, integrity, and accountability in their work, and active collaborations with other teams and departments, have proven to be effective in supporting the academic success, holistic development, and future endeavours of KPU's International Students.

During the past couple of years, International Advising can boast that due to several of their initiatives, the number of International Students in good academic standing has risen 69.8% (2017) to 85.9% (2021). One of the initiatives is a redesign of their Advising Case Management. Through this design, the Team has been able to reach out to students at crucial points throughout their studies to ensure they are making steady progress toward their goals and addressing challenges before they become larger problems.

As well, over the past year the International Advising Team has been creating a series of online resources that are easily accessible to international students all over the world. They produced 16 videos for The KPU International's YouTube Channel with topics ranging from Advising, Academic Standing to How to Apply for Graduation.

The International Advising Team also created online workshops and webinars, where each term over 700 International Students attend. They learn how to navigate the registration system and program requirements.

The International Advising Team has also been working collaboratively with the Learning Centre and implemented a pilot program for International Students wishing to return to KPU after being required to withdraw. This program provides students with the opportunity to assess their academic choices, and improve academic and time management skills and strategies through online self-learning opportunities and individual consultation with a learning strategist and an advisor.

It's demonstrated that International Students who come to KPU are excited to be here and in part it's because they know they are supported. With appropriate advising information and methods, ongoing monitoring and communication, support for re-entry students and thoughtful approaches to working with these students, the International Advising Team demonstrates what it means to be exceptional.

PROFESSOR EMERITUS

Emeritus/Emerita is an honorary appointment for life awarded to a retired employee for distinguished service and academic contributions to KPU and establishes a relationship that is both symbolic and active. The emeritus/emerita appointment recognizes distinguished performance of an employee, honours the employee's standing of high regard in the eyes of peers and colleagues, and anticipates the continuation of the employee's academic contributions to KPU past retirement.

Dr. Robert Adamoski

Dr. Robert Adamoski's distinguished career in BC post-secondary spans 21 years as a faculty member, department chair, dean, and associate vice president at Kwantlen Polytechnic University (KPU), as well as ten years as the Director, Research and Admissions, at the BC Council on Admissions and Transfer (BCCAT). His contributions to KPU as well as the post-secondary system in BC and across Canada have been significant.



Notably, Dr. Adamoski's career at KPU spans a period of significant growth and development as the institution transitioned from college to university college to polytechnic university. He participated enthusiastically and effectively as a faculty member and administrator stewarding the expansion and development of the university, its programming, its faculty, and its governance. He played a key role in the creation of governance policies at the university and guided the development of numerous degree programs during his six years as dean, while also supporting the development of a number of initiatives expanding experiential learning and undergraduate research. During his term as AVP Research and Scholarship, Dr. Adamoski led the development of KPU's policies on Integrity in Research and Scholarship, Research Involving Human Participants, and Intellectual Property.

In 2012, Dr. Adamoski left the university to join BCCAT and extended his KPU knowledge and experiences to provincial and national initiatives. There, he worked extensively on projects supporting learners and the BC post-secondary system in general. He worked to maintain and develop many of the key data sources capturing

learner experiences and system performance in the province, including chairing the Student Transitions Project, sitting as a member of the Student Outcomes Forum, and working closely with the Central Data Warehouse.

More than 40 research projects were completed during Dr. Adamoski's term as Director, Research and Admissions, covering a wide range of policy and practice across Canadian post-secondaries. Working with BC Stats, he conducted three provincial-scale student surveys. He also worked extensively with several provincial ministries, including the Ministry of Education, the Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD), as well as with the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training (AEST) with BC Sector Associations, the BC Registrar's Association, and the BC Institutional Research and Planning Association on a range of issues and projects.

Pan-Canadian projects were also an important component of Robert's work at BCCAT. He sat on Steering Committees for two national projects, leading to the implementation of the Association of Registrars of the Universities and Colleges of Canada (ARUCC) National Transcript and Transfer Guide, and the MyCreds national credential wallet. Dr. Adamoski has developed a considerable professional network across BC, Canada, and North America, and has regularly been invited to speak on student mobility, access, educational data, and other topics across the country.

Over a long career, Dr. Robert Adamoski has demonstrated exemplary contributions to KPU and BC post-secondary, and to the learners across our system. He has had the opportunity to support and provide leadership for initiatives at a provincial and national level which have informed educational policy and practice and benefited the post-secondary system more generally.

Dr. Adamoski looks forward to continuing his relationship with KPU and his colleagues, sharing his experience and conducting more research.

GOVERNOR GENERAL'S SILVER ACADEMIC MEDAL

On behalf of the Governor General of Canada, this medal is awarded to a KPU student who, in the opinion of the selection committee, has attained the highest academic standing in the graduation year of a bachelor's degree program. It is one of the highest academic honours KPU can bestow.



Karrah Parke, Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting (With Distinction)

Prior to coming to KPU, Karrah states that she really wasn't involved in many school activities or clubs, but at KPU she found the community and atmosphere so welcome that she feels a part of the student community, especially through her work as a peer tutor at the Learning Centre, and volunteering with the Accounting Society.

Karrah has been tutoring for three years and has assisted her peers with course contact, developed learning resources that would help students become independent learners, and facilitates workshops for mid-term and final exam reviews. In Fall 2020, she helped out to orient and educate incoming KPU students about university life by sharing everything that she felt led to her success as a student. In Fall 2020, Karrah had the opportunity to act as a peer mentor for three Level 1 tutors, sharing her experience and guidance. As well, she volunteered with ASK (Accounting Society of Kwantlen) as a marketing executive, vice president as well as president. She aided in planning

networking events, organized information sessions with firms, and facilitated workshops for the benefit of peer accounting students.

Volunteering at KPU inspired her to seek opportunities elsewhere. Since early 2021 Karrah has been volunteering at a non-profit called SAD Mag as their Financial Manager. This organization works to champion the voices of diverse local-based artists and creators through a bi-annual release of a print magazine and monthly online content. In addition, Karrah is a member of a local Icelandic Canadian club of BC and supports them with events.

Since November 2019 she has volunteered for ASK (Accounting Society of Kwantlen), and the summer of 2020 she received a promotion from Ambassador to Marketing Executive. In that new role, she had more responsibilities in

terms of facilitating networking events and informing students of relevant career opportunities. She also managed the ASK website and created graphic designs. In spring of 2021, she was offered the position of co-Vice President, and led the club as President by fall of that year. The event in the fall was the largest accounting event of the year which saw a dozen different firms and over 50 students in attendance. Through her experiences with ASK, not only has she been able to assist peers with their own networking, but she learned about forming relationships with firm representatives, networking etiquette, and the process of becoming a CPA. Karrah has been accepted into the Master of Professional Accounting program at the University of Saskatchewan, and hopes to use that degree to teach at a post-secondary level in the future.

GOVERNOR GENERAL'S BRONZE ACADEMIC MEDAL

On behalf of the Governor General of Canada, this medal is awarded annually to a KPU student who, in the opinion of the selection committee, has attained the highest academic standing in the graduation year of a two-year diploma program. It is one of the highest academic honours KPU can bestow.



Oran Donay, Diploma in Computer Aided Design and Drafting (With Distinction)

Originally from Israel, Oran has been with KPU for two years and is enrolled in the Computer-Aided Design and Drafting (CADD) program. Oran chose to become an engineer because of his passion for science and technology. He always wanted to learn more about how the universe works and then to use that knowledge in practice to find solutions to real problems. For him, a part of being an engineer is the ability to bring ideas to life – that is what brought him to the CADD program at KPU. He wanted to sharpen his design skills so he could be better at communicating his ideas through design.

Leaving his home and moving to Canada by himself was a very difficult decision and took a great deal of courage. As well, going back to school when you're in your mid-30's in a different country, and in the middle of a world crisis was no easy feat. To overcome the challenges he faced, he found that focusing on one obstacle at a time and giving it his full attention, helped him to move forward one step at a time.

In his spare time, Oran enjoys a good movie, reading novels, listening to music or podcasts about science and technology or working out at the gym. He appreciates receiving this award because it demonstrates the recognition of all his hard work.

Considered to be trustworthy and accountable, Oran strives to use his skills, knowledge and experience to help others. His aspirations are to take part in creating products that would improve the quality of peoples' lives and by working on new sustainable technologies.

LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR'S MEDAL

On behalf of the Lieutenant Governor of BC, this medal is awarded to a graduate who demonstrates outstanding contributions in support of inclusion, democracy and/or reconciliation on campus or in their communities. The recipient may be from any program at KPU, and will be nominated by faculty.



Emily Haugen, Bachelor of Business Administration in Marketing Management (With Distinction)

Emily considers herself to be an advocate, a feminist, a sister, an entrepreneur, and a social change-maker. Her goal in life is to achieve positive societal changes through the empowerment of women and girls, meaningful connection with our indigenous community, and protection of the environment.

During her first two years at KPU she was trying to figure out how business and social values can intersect. By attending national conferences for women and girl's rights and empowerment, women in politics, and women's networking forums, she was able to build a network of women across Canada who had the same values. She learned that marketing was a versatile knowledge-area that can be applied to literally any field, but she still wanted to learn more about the social side of business, so decided to pursue a non-profit studies certificate at the same time as working towards her BBA.

In 2019 Emily founded a female empowerment and mentorship non-profit called "She Connects" and has been able to apply what she learned in the classroom to the real-world in a way that makes impactful change. In September 2021 She Connects incorporated officially as a not-for-profit Foundation, and was recognized by the United Nations Association in Canada with the John Gibbard Award for their work contributing

to the development of youth and the betterment of humanity. She was able to use her understanding of social media marketing and web design to create various online campaigns to recruit mentors, mentees, and their board of directors. Emily says that She Connects is one of her proudest accomplishments because she believes it will impact so many lives and will foster so many relationships.

Also in 2019, Emily co-founded a School of Business student-led initiative called the KPU Case Analysis Network (KPUCAN), which aims to support student development inside and outside the classroom through case-based learning events, networking, and professional development. In the Spring of 2021 she participated in the planning and hosting a multi-day KPU Case Competition event which took several months of preparation (and brought the KPU School of Business national recognition).

For the past 4 years, Emily has been working at the Division of Family Practice in the marketing and communications department, and in her future career, she hopes to continue her work in the non-profit sector. Ideally, she would like to work at an organization that has a mission statement to support the betterment of women and girls globally, while fostering environmental protection and building meaningful relationships with indigenous peoples.

GEORGE C. WOOTTON AWARD

KPU's Board of Governors established this award to recognize outstanding dedication, service and contribution to the university system. This award considers a student's contribution to the community, KPU or voluntary activities as well as academic success.

DISTINGUISHED ALUMNI AWARD

The purpose of these awards is to recognize KPU Alumni who have enhanced the reputation of the university through their outstanding career, public service, community service, athletic, arts and culture, or academic achievements.



Winston Sayson

Winston Sayson, QC is a retired trial Crown Counsel with the British Columbia Prosecution Service, Ministry of Attorney General (1989-2019). He was the first Filipino-Chinese Canadian appointed as Queen's Counsel in British Columbia, a designation he received in recognition of "exceptional merit and contribution to the legal profession."

From 1981 to 1983, Kwantlen College (as it was then called) welcomed and provided Sayson with valuable university transfer education and experience. At the time, he was a new immigrant from the Philippines. English was his third language. Kwantlen College was instrumental to his adjustment to a new country and culture. In 2004, he received the Citation in Counselling Skills from Kwantlen University College (as it was then called), which further equipped him to be a better and more effective trial Crown Counsel.

During his career, Sayson prosecuted significant and high-profile criminal cases. He is highly regarded for his expertise in working with children and vulnerable victims

and helping them through the criminal justice system with genuine care. As he worked primarily on files dealing with violence or sexual abuse, his compassion for those he served left a lasting and positive impact on the lives of countless victims and their families. He was a leader in his profession through his commitment to mentoring others in the field. He volunteered to provide practical training to forensic nurse examiners, police officers, victim services workers, and prosecutors.

In 2006, Sayson represented the Criminal Justice Branch on a project to China with the International Centre for Criminal Law Reform and Criminal Justice Policy. The US Ambassador invited him to participate in the International Visitor Leadership program in 2009. In 2010, Sayson was awarded the Criminal Justice System Leadership Award by the Police Victim Services of British Columbia in recognition of his compassionate work with the victims of crimes and their families.

In 2011, he was appointed Queen's Counsel by the Attorney General of BC. In 2014, Sayson was honoured with the Recognizing Excellence Award from the Criminal Justice Branch of the Ministry of Justice. In 2015, he was presented with the Vision Award from the International Association of Forensic Nursing for his contribution to the promotion and advancement of forensic nursing. In 2018, Sayson received the inaugural Leadership Award from the BC Prosecution Service. In 2018, he received a 30-year Service Award from Attorney General David Eby, QC. In 2019, he received the inaugural Lawyer of Distinction Award from the Federation of Asian Canadian Lawyers, BC, and the Award of Excellence from the Surrey Women's Centre for his commitment to justice for women, girls, and victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.

Throughout his career, Sayson believed in serving the public with diligence and passion. He mentored and trained criminology practicum students, law students, articling students, and new prosecutors. He was committed to the success of others while modeling excellence in his trial work.

In his retirement, Sayson has been involved in causes and documentaries addressing issues regarding social justice and mental health. He has continued to present as a speaker on mental health and wellness. He also advocates for equality, diversity, and inclusiveness within the legal profession, the public service, and our broader community. He volunteers at his church and for the Canadian Red Cross.

Tiana Sharifi

An expert in the field of human trafficking and sexual exploitation, Tiana Sharifi is the founder of Sexual Exploitation Education (SEE), an agency which aims to prevent sexual exploitation and human trafficking through awareness, advocacy, education and consultation. Through her work, Tiana has provided prevention education to thousands of students, parents and teachers, while training hundreds of social service providers, including law enforcement. She recently provided in house training to hundreds of federal RCMP across Canada.

Tiana places importance on Indigenous education and has been an ally to agencies such as the Indigenous Perspective Society to educate workers who work directly with Indigenous youth, parents and adults. Tiana has made it a priority to educate groups working with Indigenous populations to prevent vulnerability factors that would affect an Indigenous child or youth from becoming more vulnerable to exploitation, including running a full day conference in partnership with Indigenous Training and Consulting Services.

Her consulting services have rendered her a reputable resource for research center advisory, as well as non-profit curriculum development. Tiana currently sits as the Co-Executive Director for the international non-profit The Breakfree Collective, and was the co-author and consultant for first ever BC research on the digital presence of human trafficking, completed in May of this year. She has recently been the first to release an app on sexual exploitation prevention, called the SEE-App.

KPU is very pleased to be awarding Tiana as the inaugural recipient of the 2022 Alumni Excellence award. This new award aims to honour KPU alumni who are having a significant impact.

OUTSTANDING YOUNG ALUMNI AWARD

Gurkirat Singh Nijjar

Gurkirat came to KPU in 2015 as an international student and he quickly became instrumental in developing and supporting several important community service initiatives.

As founder of a non-profit youth led organization called Students Overcoming Substance Use Disorder and Addictions Society of Canada (SOUDA), Gurkirat is responsible for bringing life-saving resources to our community. Since September 2019, Gurkirat led his team of volunteers to setup Overdose Response and Prevention Booths at local places of worship, parks, colleges, community events and even construction sites. Gurkirat organizes and manages team SOUDA and volunteers to provide awareness on the Opioid Overdose Crisis and Drug toxicity. His team provides education, resources, on-site Naloxone training and conversation to break the stigma and encourage harm reduction strategies. His organization provides these services in four languages English, Punjabi, Urdu, and Hindi. The organization has been at the

forefront of giving the south Asian community this culturally relevant resource, which has helped so many families.

In addition to his studies at KPU and his dedication to the Opioid crisis, Gurkirat was also involved in improving pedestrian road safety in Newton by organizing and leading a road safety campaign. He is also a coach, group leader and volunteer at Chimo Crisis Line, supporting crisis intervention. In addition, during COVID Gurkirat served as a bridge between KPU International student services with the South Asian COVID19 Task Force to share COVID related information and resources. Gurkirat is also involved in many religious programs at local Sikh Gurudwara in Surrey. He serves as a volunteer in the community Kitchen of Guru Nanak Sikh Gurdwara. He is involved in the food bank which provides services for International students of all ethnicities. He is also a Fraser Health wellness ambassador and serves as a community outreach director at One Voice Canada.

Gurkirat is a tremendous leader and an example of selfless community service. He is well deserving of the recognition of Outstanding Young Alumni.

DEAN'S MEDAL

and Non-Profit Studies are effusive in their appreciation of Kamaljit's leadership, her support for her fellow students, and her contribution to their programs.

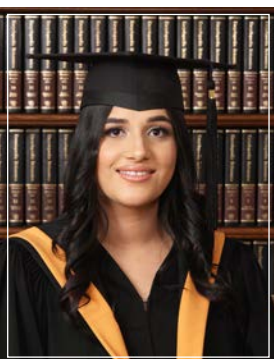


Melville School of Business

CONVOCATION TRADITIONS

HERALDRY



KWANTLEN POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY

The Arms of Kwantlen Polytechnic University were presented at a ceremony on May 4, 1999 by the Right Honourable Romeo LeBlanc, Governor General of Canada.

The centre shield features 'The Spirit of KPU' emblem comprising a wolf, a salmon, and a river azure as styled by Brandon Gabriel.

At the top of the blue shield, on the left side a lion and on the right a tiger facing each other in the rampant position (upright on one hind leg with forelegs outstretched as if attacking). And at the bottom of the blue shield, on the left a jaguar and on the right a Chinese dragon also facing each other in the rampant position. All are gold.

At the top in the centre, there is an open book with silver or white pages, bindings in gold and on top of it, a gold horizontal (in fess) rectangle (billet) with square bites taken out of the long sides (bretessed). In modern heraldry, this item is meant to represent a computer chip.

The crest appears above the shield, and is supported by a silver and blue twisted fabric wreath. The upper rim is set with a simple silver crown, the upper edge decorated with four salmon, looking at each other in pairs.

Supporting the arms is a green grassy mound, scattered with gold Douglas Fir cones. The mound is rising from wavy horizontal bands of blue and silver. This is the traditional heraldic representation of water - either river or ocean.

On the left is a gold female deer with blue hooves, and her bottom half is a silver fishtail with gold fins. Around her neck is a wreath of twisted silver and blue cloth. Hanging from the wreath is a green disk with an open book on it—the pages are silver; the cover is gold.

On the right is a gold eagle with a silver head, with blue talons and beak. Around his neck is a wreath like the doe's and hanging from it is a green disk with the heraldic representation of a gold computer chip.

The motto reads: Through Tireless Effort, Knowledge and Understanding.

UNIVERSITY MACE



The mace was originally a weapon during the medieval period, and came to be associated with the prowess and strength of the knight. Today the mace is a symbol of the University's authority to award degrees and diplomas. It indicates the seriousness of convocation as the University's most important academic ceremony, and is a confirmation of the University's integrity as an academic institution. The mace is carried by a mace-bearer, who leads the processional of faculty and students in to and out of the venue where convocation is held. The mace is usually between four feet and six feet in length and will incorporate the history and tradition that surround the vision for the University.

An academic mace symbolizes the authority vested in the chancellor to confer university credentials. This is why the mace is an integral part of convocation.

Maces are often commissioned to commemorate a milestone anniversary or presidential inauguration. Typically an artist is selected for the honour to develop a highly symbolic design that incorporates the University's traditions.

KPU's mace was carved by Kwantlen First Nation artist Drew Atkins.

REGALIA

Not until they slip into their regalia, do many graduands realize the significance of their convocation ceremony. For family and friends, the first glimpse of the graduand in cap and gown heralds a milestone in the life of their loved one.

Standard for Academic Dress

At KPU, all graduates wear a black gown of Oxford shape and a black cap with a black tassel. Graduates of our bachelor's degree programs wear hoods in the Aberdeen style, made of black pilgrim cloth and bordered with a one half inch border. The border of each hood is a specific colour that identifies a particular area of study.

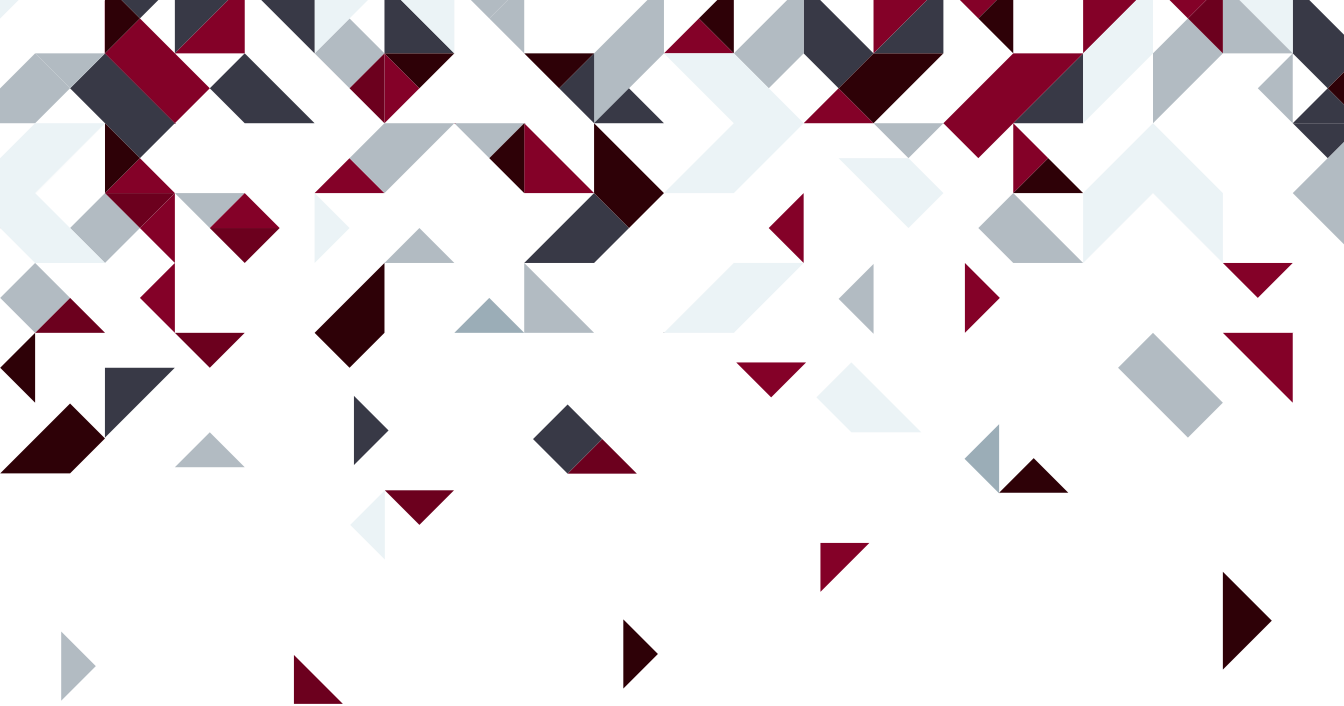
