Family and friends are requested to rise when the graduands' procession enters. The assembly is requested to remain standing until the conclusion of the singing of **O Canada**.

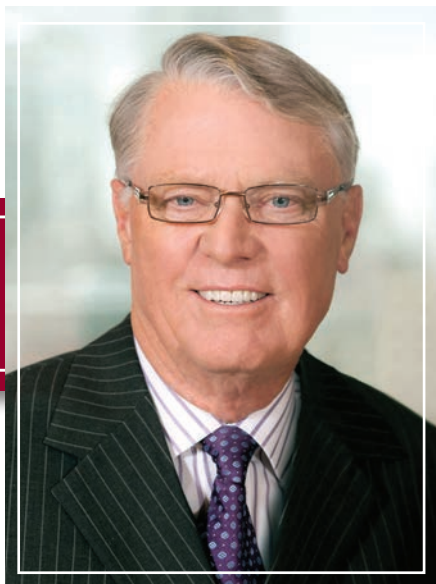
Convocation will conclude with the recession of the platform party, floor party and graduates, during which everyone is requested to remain standing.

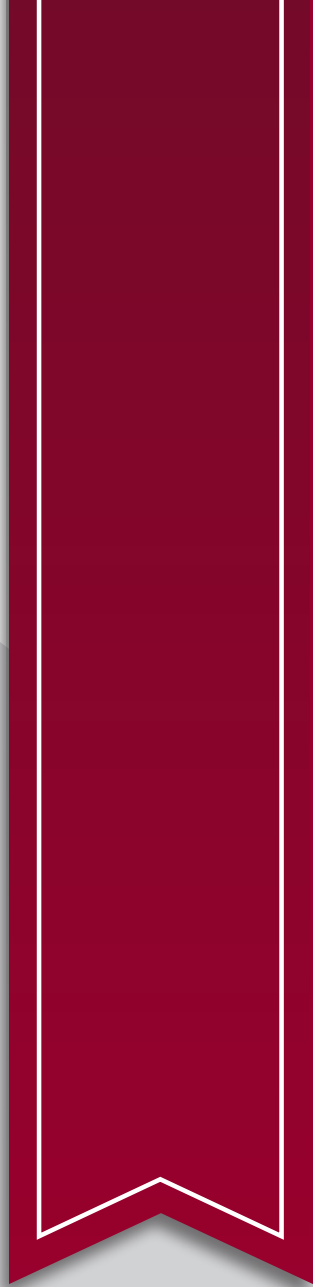

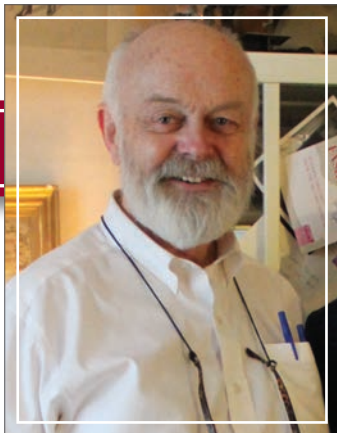

Honorary Doctor of Laws (Honoris Causa)

Ivan Sayers

Ivan Sayers is a fashion historian who has been amassing vintage women's, men's and children's apparel for decades and now has one of the biggest privately held collections of vintage clothing in the country. He's acquired hundreds of articles from thrift stores, and many other pieces have been gifted to him by people who are comforted knowing he will treat their apparel as the treasures they are.

Sayers views fashion as a remarkable reflection of society aesthetically, politically, economically, socially and technologically. It's a subject worthy of significant study, and so Sayers has been sharing his insights with post-secondary students and members of the public through guest lectures, exhibits and collaborations with community groups and other organizations since the 1970s.

Sayers is a well-known presenter and expert speaker (someone once stopped him on the street and said, "Hey, aren't you that guy with all the dresses? I saw you on TV.") and he's sometimes booked two and three years in advance. Still, he always makes time for KPU design students and for more than 30 years has developed lectures for students and faculty illuminating the elusive movement of trends impacted by the various socio-cultural events of each era. Through his commitment to these lectures, students gain respect and learn from history to plan for the sustainable global future of the apparel industry.

Jim Sinclair

Throughout Jim Sinclair's career, he has been a strong advocate for the rights of all working people to a safe workplace and fair wages, and has been a vocal supporter of public services that support the needs of our communities. His commitment to working people began early in his life, walking his first picket line when he was 17 years old in support of striking immigrant women seeking a first collective agreement. He worked as a youth worker in the Ontario Housing Projects and as a staff member of the Latin American Working Group.

For the last 15 years Jim was the President of the BC Federation of Labour - 1999 to 2014. The BCFED represents over 500,000 members from affiliated unions across the province, working in every aspect of the BC economy.

Under his leadership the Federation has become a strong voice for all working people, especially some of the most exploited and underpaid workers in our province, such as farmworkers, silviculture workers, late night gas station attendants and minimum wage workers.

Prior to his time as president, Jim spent 18 years at the United Fishermen and Allied Workers' Union, where he held a number of positions including Associate Editor of the union newspaper, Health and Safety Director, Organizer, and as an elected officer of the union.

He lives in Port Moody with long-time partner Susan. They have one son, Lee, who is a shipyard worker and a musician.

Linda May Bickerton-Ross

Linda gained an Artist Diploma (Performance) from the University of Toronto and subsequently studied with Carlos Buhler in New York. She taught and coached both in Vancouver and at the Victoria Conservatory of Music. Performances during these early years included a premiere for Two Pianos and Electronic Music by Anthony Gnazzo at the Edward Johnson Hall in Toronto and two CBC solo radio concerts.

Linda met Marilyn Lamont when she moved to Langley in the late 1960s. As friends, they discussed their desire to start a music school in Langley. After co-founding LCMS, Linda taught piano and pioneered the Orff program at the school. With Marilyn, she was directly involved in the administration and management of the school during its early years. At its conception Linda developed the objectives of the school that provided its purpose and that continue to inspire its direction today. She also played a prominent role in developing the constitution and early bylaws of the school. Linda's clarity of vision made a strong contribution to the success of the school in its early years.

Linda made the difficult decision to leave LCMS in the late 1970s to raise her family. While raising her family, Linda earned a BA (U. West. Washington '79) (Magna Cum Laude) and a MA (SFU '88). She became a highly respected principal in the Surrey School District. Over the past many years, Linda has maintained a strong relationship with LCMS and served on its Board from time to time. Now retired, she continues to support the school as a Founder and Life Member.

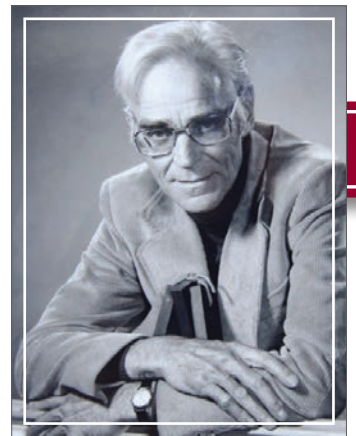


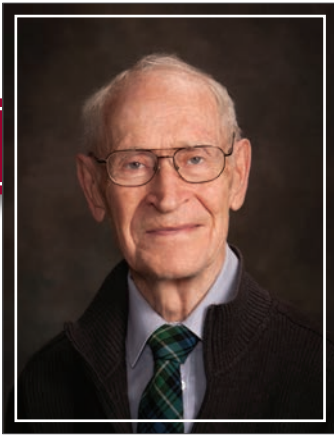

Peter Maxwell Ewart

Peter was born in Kisbey, Saskatchewan in 1918 but grew up in Montreal. His parents encouraged his strong aptitude for drawing and painting, and after graduating high school Peter decided he wanted to be an artist. He studied commercial art in Montreal at Sir George Williams College (now Concordia University) and the Art Association of Montreal (now Musee des Beaux Arts) and in 1938 he enrolled in the Commercial Illustration Studio in New York City. He developed his career as a professional artist while working in commercial art and his works have been widely exhibited in Canada and elsewhere. He had more than 40 solo exhibitions and his paintings are represented in numerous corporate and private collections in Canada and abroad.

Peter admired the immense beauty of the BC landscape and seacoast while serving with the RCAF during the war. After being discharged he moved from Montreal to B.C. and later to Langley. His love of the arts led him to envision building an arts centre on his five-acre property in Langley City. Although his application to erect the building he designed himself was initially denied by council, he soon teamed up with Dr. Keith Lamont and in August 1969, they reapplied together and council approved the arts centre in Langley City Park. It became a reality in 1970, and the Langley Community Music School emerged from the arts centre as a non-profit society in 1972. A fine example of Peter's work adorns the foyer of LCMS.





Honorary Doctor of Letters (Honoris Causa)

Keith Alexander Lamont

Born in Flin Flon, Manitoba in 1929, Keith earned his medical degree and completed his surgical training at the Winnipeg General Hospital before moving to the U.S. for graduate training. In Boston, he did post-graduate work with the Harvard Service for the Massachusetts General Hospital.

Keith and his wife, Marilyn, moved their young family of three daughters and a son to Langley in 1967. There they met and befriended Peter Ewart and Leonard Woods and eventually Linda Bickerton-Ross and the dream began of starting a music school together.

Unable to find a suitable building to launch, Keith offered to finance the building of an arts centre that would house a music school, and to donate it to the City of Langley. The council of the day agreed to the proposal and an agreement was drawn up in 1969. Keith's long service to the LCMS as a co-founder, director and life member has been exemplary.

Now retired as a physician, Keith is known for his commitment to medicine and the arts. Along with Marilyn he continues to support and attend classical music concerts in B.C. and Alberta. As a surgeon, Dr. Lamont had a long and distinguished career at Langley Memorial Hospital where he was known both for his professional skill and for his kind and respectful manner with his patients. For more than 30 years, Keith mentored young doctors, always emphasizing the importance of upholding a standard of care far beyond the norm.

Keith Lamont is enormously respected in the community of Langley as a surgeon, a patron of the arts and as a Founder of the LCMS.

Marilyn Henrietta Lamont

Marilyn was born in 1931 outside Kinistino, Saskatchewan, where her aptitude for music was recognized early and prompted weekly trips between the farm and Kinistino for piano lessons. In the winter, warmed by a small on-board stove fashioned by her inventive father, Marilyn made the journey on a caboose sleigh.

Marilyn earned a Licentiate of the Royal Schools of Music followed by a B.Mus in Piano Performance at the University of Washington. Marilyn's performances during this time included work with both the CBC Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra and the CBC Symphony on CBC Radio.

After co-founding the LCMS, Marilyn dedicated her professional life to teaching piano at LCMS. She was a highly respected teacher and mentor preparing students for Royal Conservatory of Music exams as well as supporting young and experienced teachers alike. Throughout her time at LCMS, Marilyn was active as a performer, giving numerous solo and two piano performances with Linda. Marilyn continued to give frequent solo and chamber performances at Master Classes and Faculty Benefit Concerts. In later years she premiered performances of two of Leonard Woods's piano sonatas.

Marilyn's skill's as a networker resulted in early support for LCMS from musicians and the community. Her early life experiences, characterized by an ability to overcome obstacles and meet challenges, were a vital force in the fragile formative years of LCMS. Her unwavering leadership provided a steady compass that steered the school over many years to the recognition and success it enjoys today. Along with her husband, Keith, she has been a long-standing patron of the LCMS.

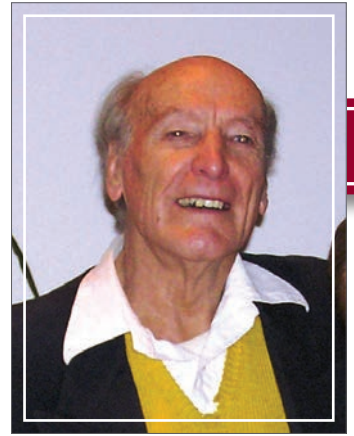
Leonard Archibald Woods

Leonard was born in Stonewall, Manitoba in 1919. He entered the Winnipeg School of Art to study under Lionel LeMoine Fitzgerald of the Group of Seven fame and graduated with a Diploma in Art in 1940. He studied concurrently at the deMarin School of Sculpture and started teaching first-year courses in sculpture at the Winnipeg School of Art until the Second World War intervened. Medically discharged, he enrolled in the Ontario College of Art, where he studied sculpture and graduated with honours. Leonard moved to Langley in 1945 and lectured in sculpture and art history at the Vancouver School of Art (now the Emily Carr University of Art + Design) from 1945 to 1969.

A tenor and accomplished musician, Leonard was a foundation member of the Maysfield Singers. He was asked by Peter, Keith, and Marilyn to join them in developing a music education program that would become the LCMS. Known as something of a polymath and Renaissance man, Leonard also taught at the school for many years and served on the Board.

Leonard remained a strong and proud supporter of LCMS all his life and donated various art works of his own to the school as well as other works from his collection. As well, he premiered several of his own compositions at LCMS and was always available to offer a learned and considered point of view.

Leonard's publications included a private printing of poetry "Breakfast Dialogue" 2014 and the book "Meditations on the Art of Carl Hessay," 2005.

Shannon Wilson

Shannon Wilson is a Canadian fashion designer, philanthropist and businesswoman. Shannon founded Kit and Ace Designs where technical cashmere was born by elevating luxury fabrications, while applying technical and functional attributes. Shannon is also well known for her former role as lead designer of lululemon athletica Inc. where she designed some of the company's most successful and iconic products – including the groove pants and logo hoodie.

Shannon is passionate about elevating the world through primary education. In 2007, she and her husband Chip launched a non-profit organization and named it imagine1day as she imagines a day when all children in Ethiopia receive a primary education. imagine1day is committed to providing all Ethiopians quality education funded free of foreign aid by 2030.

In 2012, the Wilson family donated \$1.5 million to the Vancouver Biennale for the specific purpose of gifting “A-maze-ing Laughter” to the City of Vancouver. “A-maze-ing Laughter” is a metal sculpture designed by Yue Minjun and currently sits in Morton Park in Vancouver, BC.

Shannon received a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Fashion Design from the University of Victoria and an Honorary Doctorate from Emily Carr University of Art and Design. She has accomplished all of this while being the busy mother of three children.

Chip Wilson

Chip Wilson is an entrepreneur and business leader. Chip is best known as the founder and former Chairman of the yoga-inspired company lululemon athletica, and as a visionary in technical apparel. Chip founded his first retail apparel company, Westbeach Snowboard Ltd., in 1979. The venture sold apparel targeted at the emerging surf, skate, and snowboard markets. He sold Westbeach in 1997 and founded lululemon athletica in 1998. Chip currently chairs his wife and son's apparel company “Kit and Ace”, which specializes in technical cashmere. He has also started a new venture with his wife Shannon called Whil; a 60 second meditation designed as a way to temporarily shut down the brain, set personal commitments, and power forward to boost productivity. In 2004, Ernst & Young named Chip Canadian Entrepreneur of the Year for Innovation and Marketing and in 2012 the University of Victoria presented him the “Distinguished Entrepreneur” award.

Chip is the pioneer of numerous philanthropic ventures. Together, Chip and Shannon founded the Chip and Shannon Wilson School of Design at KPU, committed to educating students in innovative design for fashion, interiors, graphics, product and technical apparel. The school will include new teaching studios, gallery space for student exhibitions and a “usability lab” where students can design, prototype and market product concepts. Chip also enjoys giving back to his home city, Vancouver. He sponsors a yearly children's run with B.C. Children's Hospital and in 2012 he donated funds to restore 14 of the city's most beloved statues. Chip is the proud father of five sons.



Distinguished Service Award, Faculty Division

Takashi Sato

Dr. Takashi (Tak) Sato has been an instructor at KPU since 1996 and has worked tirelessly to improve KPU. He joined the Education Council (now Senate in 2004) and was instrumental in researching the requirements for Kwantlen to move from a University College to a Polytechnic University.

Tak quickly became immersed in Senate work, becoming chair one year after joining. The time commitments greatly increased and the learning curve was steep, but Tak took on the position enthusiastically. In 2008, he established a working group to research the requirements for Kwantlen to move from a University College to a Polytechnic University; when this became a reality, he took a leadership role in creating the infrastructure that would become the Senate. Working through the summer, Tak researched university Senates and their Standing Committees, writing briefing documents for the Senate Creation Committee which met every two weeks. Each meeting, he would face critiques and revise the work for the next meeting.

As chair of the transitional Senate, he led the establishment of various Standing Committees, populated them, and supported them as they began operating. Tak was at the center of the transitional change, guiding the new Senate through the complexity and diversity of the group that comprise a new university and continued to communicate with other Senates on how they dealt with issues that arose at KPU. His dedication to KPU did not end upon completion of his time as chair. He continues to remain on the Senate Tributes Committee.

Outside of Senate Tak fosters innovative learning at KPU. Recognizing the opportunity to develop a physics programme that serves the KPU region, Tak is one of the developers of the Bachelor of Science in Physics for Modern Technology Degree. He has continued to develop astronomy courses at KPU, striving to incorporate active student involvement to promote learning; classes now involve group-work, lab work, astronomical observations, and a field trip. These classes are often filled with non-science students and are a testament to Tak's contribution in increasing scientific literacy at KPU. Additionally, he was once of the first adopters of an open text book in a BC public postsecondary institution, which has saved each student hundreds of dollars. He has been hailed by BCcampus as a pioneer.

Lisa Robinson Kitt

She holds a Master's Degree in Nursing from the University of British Columbia and was recognized by the institution as the first Aboriginal graduate of the Nurse Practitioner program. Tania is a dedicated advocate and role model for Aboriginal people interested in pursuing health care related education and serves as a nurse mentor to students in the KPU BSN Post Baccalaureate program. She recently served as a Consultant for Aboriginal Health Policy with the BC Nurses' Union where she worked directly to foster quality health care for Aboriginals as well as provide support for other Aboriginal nurses. In July 2013, Tania was elected as a Director at Large for the Association of Registered Nurses of BC (ARNBC), and in June 2015 she will be the incoming President Elect for ARNBC. Tania is from the Dzawada'enuxw First Nations Band of Kingcome Inlet, BC and has applied her expertise and own personal understanding of the challenges faced by Aboriginal communities to her practice in places such as Bella Bella, Alert Bay, Massett on Haida Gwaii, and Kingcome Inlet. Her devotion to vulnerable and disadvantaged Aboriginal populations serves as an inspiration to health care professionals and community members alike. She is also determined to improve the very limited primary health care available in remote regions of British Columbia.

Ken Puls

Ken Puls started his career in public practice accounting and spent five years working with small businesses before moving into private industry accounting where he also became an expert in Microsoft Excel in the process. He created a website which hosts a large knowledgebase of Excel help articles, a blog, and an active forum dedicated to helping users with their Excel issues. The website has almost 400,000 unique visitors annually, and has even been referenced by NASA in a project for reporting power levels on the International Space Station. For the past several years, Ken has been teaching courses for companies and associations around the globe, showing Excel users how to get the most out of the program. His public contributions have earned him the Microsoft MVP award every year since 2006; an award given annually to "the best and brightest from technology communities around the world". He was recognized as one of Vancouver Island's "Top 20 under 40" business and community leaders in 2013 and as a fellow of the Certified Management Accountants of Canada (FCMA) - an honour held by less than 5% of CMA's. On behalf of the Governor General of Canada, this medal is awarded annually to a KPU student who, in the opinion of the selection committee, has attained the highest academic standing in the graduation year of a two-year diploma program. It is one of the highest academic honours KPU can bestow.



Lieutenant Governor's Medal

Leanne Hall, *Access Programs for People with Disabilities Vocational Skills Training and Early Child Education Assistant Certificate*

To say Leanne is determined is an understatement. Her continued passion and hard work have paid off, earning her the Lieutenant Governor's Medal.

Her desire to work with children stems back to elementary school and working hard to complete both the Training Childcare Aide and VST Early Childhood Education Assistant programs. In addition to focusing on her education, Leanne served as a mentor and tutor to other students.

Currently, she is the Chair of the Surrey APPD Alumni Group and works full-time in childcare. Leanne is a committed volunteer and continues to coach young children in bowling—something she has done for many years.

On behalf of the Lieutenant Governor of B.C., this medal is awarded to a graduate studying a substantial vocational or career program of fewer than two years, as well as someone who has excelled in their studies, and contributed in a positive way to KPU or the community.

Hanrick Kumar, *Bachelor of Arts, Major in English*

During his time with the English Department, Hanrick has witnessed the power of words first hand.

Feeling that KPU could use a social and friendly environment for English students, he opted to create the Kwantlen English Commons (KEC), and being a movie fan, created the Kwantlen Film Club (KFC) which provides a space for students, faculty, and guests to discuss and enjoy films and bring people together.

Hanrick also co-founded a high school outreach program, Frontier Poetics, which encourages young people to express themselves through rap, poetry, and spoken word, and teaches students that their voice matters.

It is this passion that has driven Hanrick to want to become a high school English teacher, where he can continue to encourage and motivate students to engage with the community and embrace their creativity.

KPU's Board of Governors established this award to recognize outstanding dedication, service and contribution to the university system. This award considers a student's contribution to the community, KPU or voluntary activities as well as academic success.

Sarah has always wanted to help people and realized quickly that her passion was in psychiatric nursing. She advocates for patients with mental health issues and brings awareness to the importance of mental health.

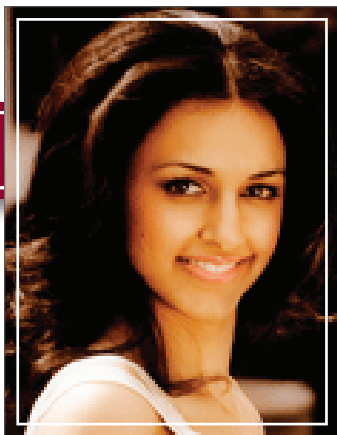

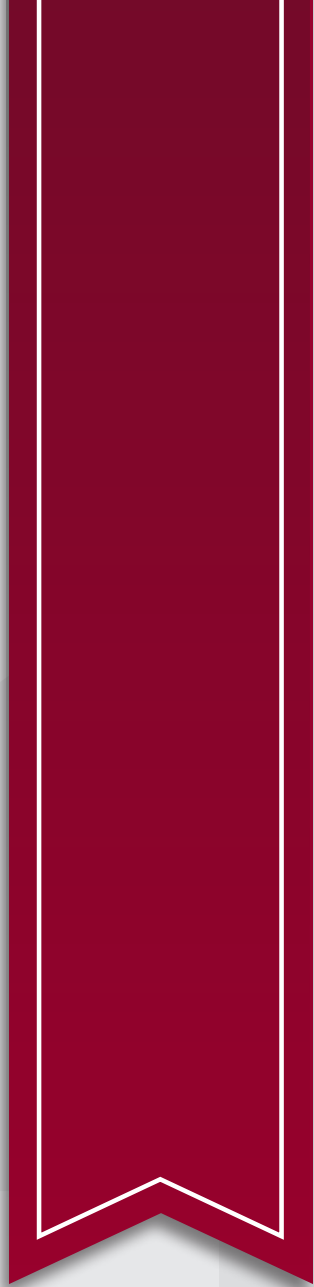

Convocation Traditions



Heraldry



The Arms of Kwantlen Polytechnic University were presented at a ceremony on May 4, 1999 by the Right Honourable Romeo LeBlanc, Governor General of Canada.

The centre shield features 'The Spirit of KPU' emblem comprising a wolf, a salmon, and a river azure as styled by Brandon Gabriel.

At the top of the blue shield, on the left side a lion and on the right a tiger facing each other in the rampant position (upright on one hind leg with forelegs outstretched as if attacking). And at the bottom of the blue shield, on the left a jaguar and on the right a Chinese dragon also facing each other in the rampant position. All are gold.

At the top in the centre, there is an open book with silver or white pages, bindings in gold and on top of it, a gold horizontal (in fess) rectangle (billet) with square bites taken out of the long sides

(bretessed). In modern heraldry, this item is meant to represent a computer chip.

The crest appears above the shield, and is supported by a silver and blue twisted fabric wreath. The upper rim is set with a simple silver crown, the upper edge decorated with four salmon, looking at each other in pairs.

Supporting the arms is a green grassy mound, scattered with gold Douglas Fir cones. The mound is rising from wavy horizontal bands of blue and silver. This is the traditional heraldic representation of water - either river or ocean.

On the left is a gold female deer with blue hooves, and her bottom half is a silver fishtail with gold fins. Around her neck is a wreath of twisted silver and blue cloth. Hanging from the wreath is a green disk with an open book on it—the pages are silver; the cover is gold.

On the right is a gold eagle with a silver head, with blue talons and beak. Around his neck is a wreath like the doe's and hanging from it is a green disk with the heraldic representation of a gold computer chip.

The motto reads: Through Tireless Effort, Knowledge and Understanding.

University Mace



The mace was originally a weapon during the medieval period, and came to be associated with the prowess and strength of the knight. Today the mace is a symbol of the University's authority to award degrees and diplomas. It indicates the seriousness of convocation as the University's most important academic ceremony, and is a confirmation of the University's integrity as an academic institution. The mace is carried by a mace-bearer, who leads the processional of faculty and students in to and out of the venue where convocation is held. The mace is usually between four feet and six

feet in length and will incorporate the history and tradition that surround the vision for the University.

An academic mace symbolizes the authority vested in the chancellor to confer university credentials. This is why the mace is an integral part of convocation.

Maces are often commissioned to commemorate a milestone anniversary or presidential inauguration. Typically an artist is selected for the honour to develop a highly symbolic design that incorporates the University's traditions.

KPU's mace was carved by Kwantlen First Nation artist Drew Atkins.



Regalia

Not until they slip into their regalia, do many graduands realize the significance of their convocation ceremony. For family and friends, the first glimpse of the graduand in cap and gown heralds a milestone in the life of their loved one.

Standard for Academic Dress

At KPU, all graduates wear a black gown of Oxford shape and a black cap with a black tassel. Graduates of our bachelor's degree programs wear hoods in the Aberdeen style, made of black pilgrim cloth and bordered with a one half inch border. The border of each hood is a specific colour that identifies a particular area of study.

The gown is of Oxford shape using maroon pilgrim cloth for the body and sleeves, with three navy blue velvet chevrons and silver velvet panels. Hoods for honorary graduates are of intercollegiate style, maroon in colour to match the gowns, with a sugarbeet satin lining, a silver satin chevron and trim, and grey piping.
