Good morning,

This is a reminder that as part of the unified login initiative by IT, Moodle Logins will have email authentication enabled **March 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024**. Logging in with an email address will bring Moodle logins in line with the Single Sign-On authentication that all other KPU systems use. Please watch this video to see an overview of this change:

There will be few important changes for faculty as a result of this initiative:

- Logging in with an email address will create a new Moodle account for faculty. Please note faculty members will not lose access to any Banner enrolled courses. However, all manual courses, such as development and community sites, will not be accessible through this new account.

Not to worry, we have a solution!

- Teaching and Learning will manually merge your new account to include your manual courses, such as development and community sites. **\*\*\*Note: This process cannot take place until the faculty member logs in using their email address\*\*\***

Important Note: Students will not be affected by these changes and can seamlessly log in through their email accounts once enabled.

### **ACTION REQUIRED**

**Once this change takes effect on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, please go to your Moodle site and log in using your KPU email. The option to continue logging in with a Banner ID will remain in place until approximately May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, after which logging in through email address will be the only available method.**
