

Subject: Important Notice: Moodle login change process begins late February 2024

Hello,

As part of the unified login change initiative by IT, Moodle Logins will have email authentication enabled late February, 2024. Logging in with an email address will bring Moodle logins in line with the Single Sign-On authentication that all other KPU systems use.

There will be few important changes for faculty as a result of this initiative.

- Logging in with an email address will create a new Moodle account for faculty. This means that any manually created courses, such as community or development sites, will not be linked to this new account.

Not to worry, we have a solution!

- Teaching and Learning will manually update these new faculty accounts to merge with the existing banner ID accounts to ensure ongoing access to manually created courses sites, which are typically in development or community. *Note: This process cannot take place until each faculty members logs in using their email address at least once.*

Important Note: Students will not be affected by these changes and can seamlessly log in through their email accounts once enabled. We will send a reminder when the email login is activated for you to go to Moodle and log in using your KPU email address. The option to continue logging in with a Banner ID will remain in place until approximately May 1, 2024, after which logging in through email address will be the only available method.
