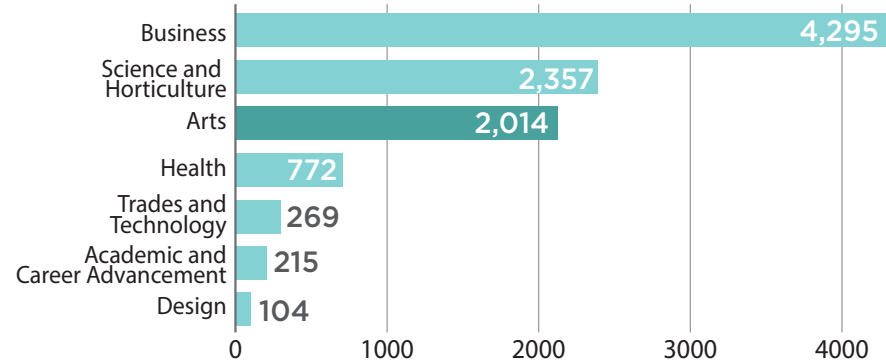
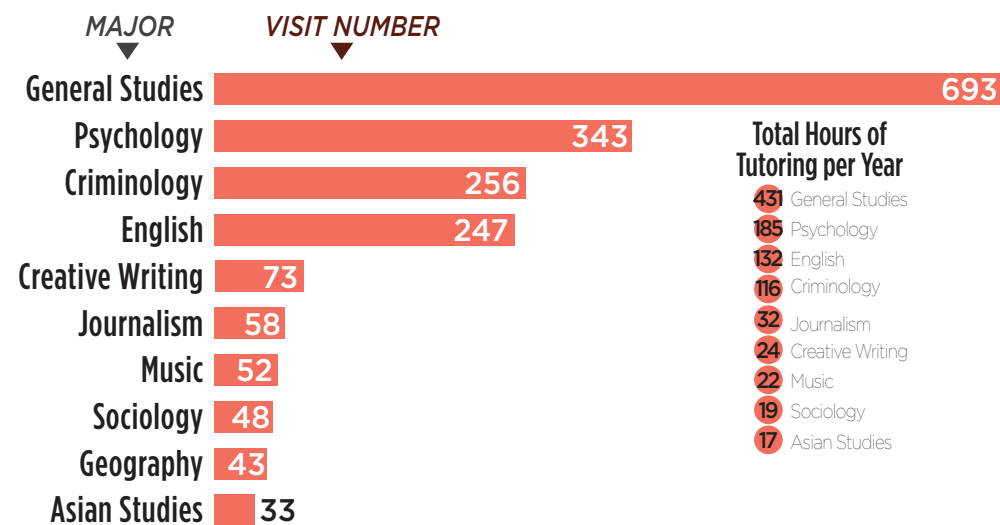

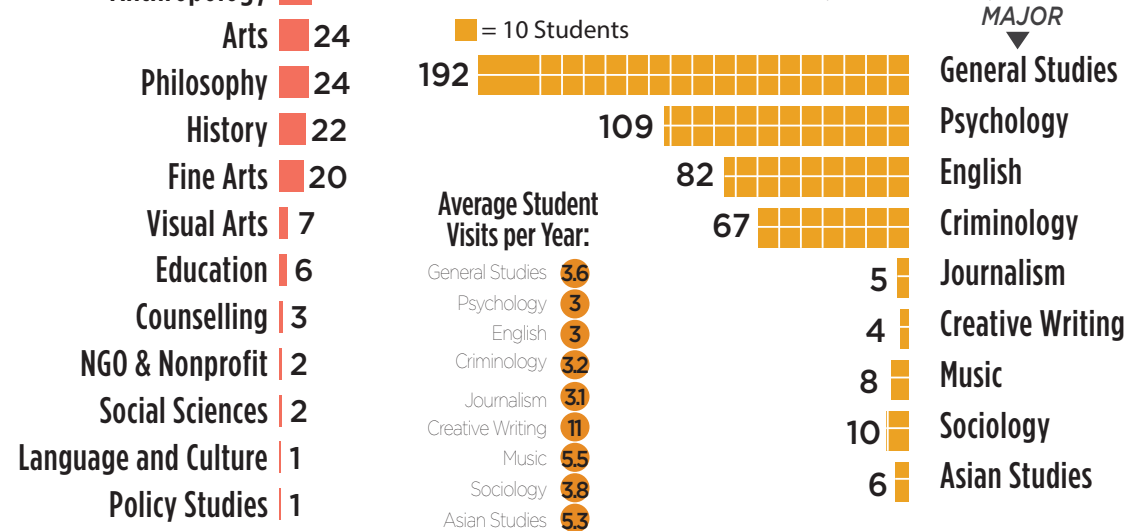
## Learning Centres Faculty Breakdown, 2015-2016



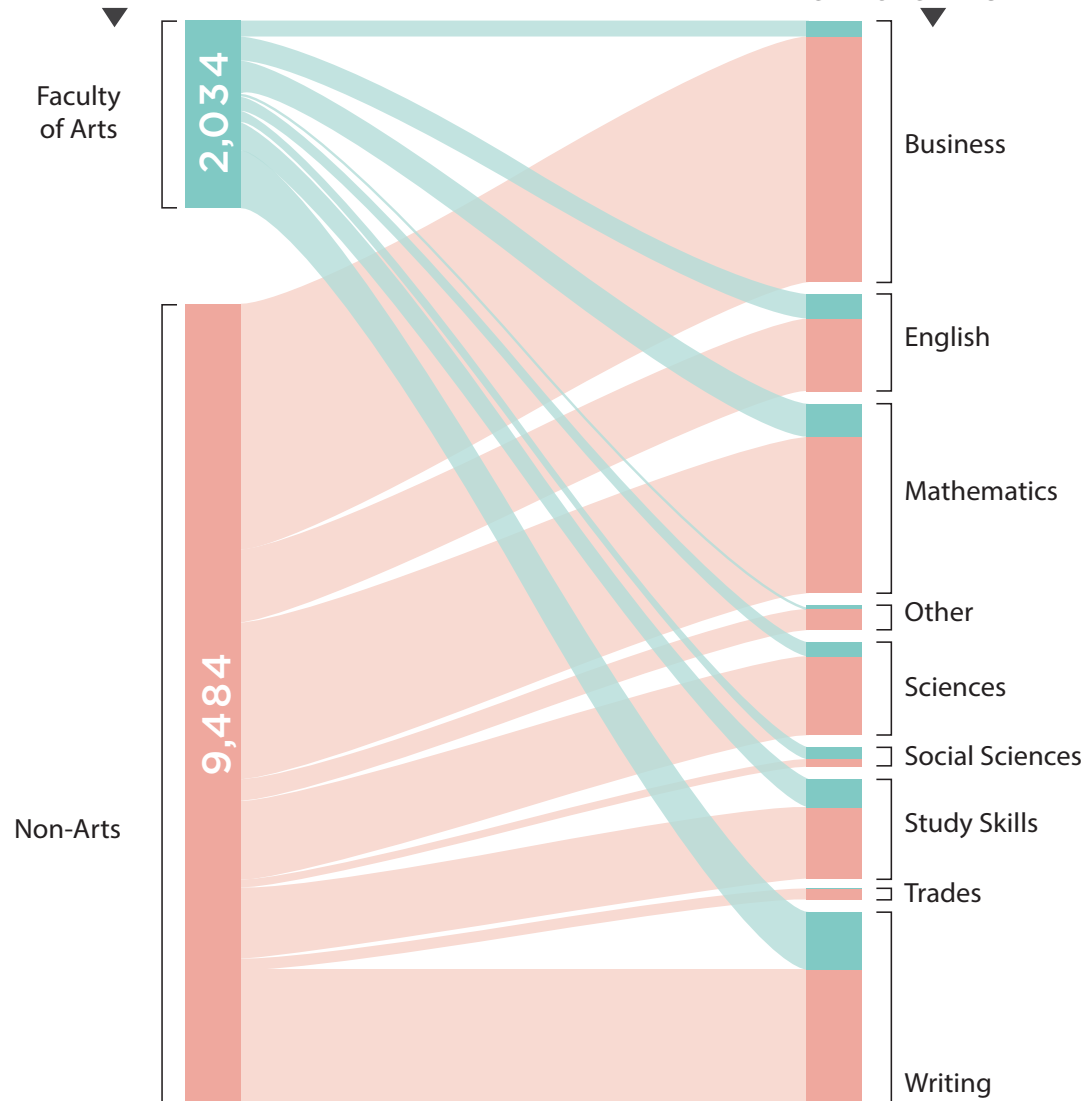
## Visits Per Program Area, Arts Faculty, 2015-2016

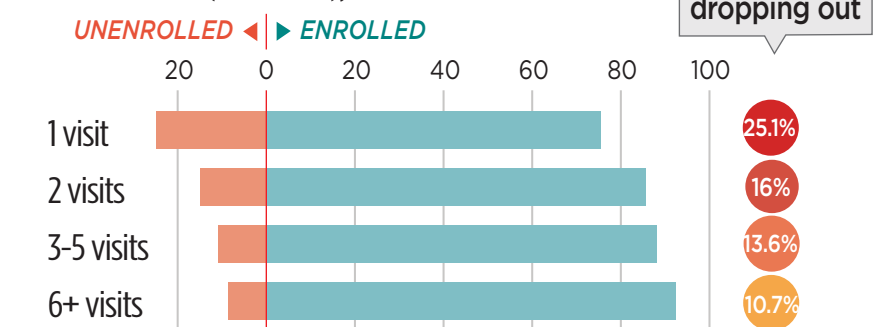
