


University libraries are for everyone

Books are just the beginning at Kwantlen Polytechnic University's (KPU) library.

"I think the KPU library, like most libraries, is an untapped resource for the public," said Todd Mundle, University Librarian at KPU. "It's not just the books, we have digital resources, public events, learning aids and people who can help literally any individual in their pursuit of knowledge."

Like a public library, the Coast Capital Savings Library at KPU is open and free to any member of the community. Permanent residents of B.C. (over the age of 14) can be issued a community borrower library card free of charge.

KPU has four libraries conveniently located on each KPU campus in Surrey, Richmond, Langley, and Cloverdale.

British Columbians can borrow up to five general collection items at a time for three weeks with the possibility of renewal. They can even take their KPU library to go with the mobile library app Bookmyne.

While on-site at any of the four locations, visitors may use guest computers, reference books, journals, videos and DVDs, and have access to wi-fi. KPU's libraries often host free public events including the upcoming Wikipedia edit-a-thon on Sept. 18 at the Surrey campus library.

To apply for a KPU library community borrower card, visit any KPU Library during <u>library hours</u>, bring two piece of photo ID, and proof of current permanent address, such as addressed mail or a driver's licence.
