INDIGENIZATION AT KPU

KPU takes its name from the Kwantlen First Nation.

The word 'Kwantlen' means Tireless Runner, and is reflected in the university's motto: "through tireless effort, knowledge, and understanding."

We work, study, and live on the unceded traditional and ancestral lands of the Kwantlen, Musqueam, Katzie, Semiahmoo, Tsawwassen, Qayqayt and Kwikwetlem peoples.

With an Aboriginal Gathering Place on campus, an Elder in Residence, a dedicated Indigenous Student Services Office, and through continued involvement with local communities, KPU is committed to meaningful indigenous engagement across its campuses.


